2144-2154 West Lawrence Ave - commonly known as 2150 West Lawrence - **O2016-5550**

A proposed ordinance seeking a zoning change B1-1 Neighborhood Shopping District to B3-5 Community Shopping District. The property will be developed with a 5 story 58 foot (62 feet to the top of the parapet wall) mixed-use building. The building consists of 59 dwelling units and 4775 square feet of commercial space. The property will provide 47 off-street parking spaces.
