ISSUE: Whether representation of this company violates the provisions in Section 10 of the Executive Order and/or Section 26.2-9(a) and (c) or 26.2-10 of the Ordinance.

STAFF CONCLUSIONS & RECOMMENDATIONS: It is the opinion of the staff that [REDACTED] X representation of the [REDACTED] does not constitute a violation of Section 26.2-9(a) of the Ordinance since his duties as [REDACTED] of the [REDACTED] Commission are wholly unrelated to his proposed representation of the [REDACTED] [REDACTED]
