O2023-1387 SUMMARY

The goal of the ordinance O2023-13877 is to re-allocate \$4,537,000 from the 925 account to represent awards:

- \$2,000,000 to the Department of Housing from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the South Shore Homeownership Program and,
- \$2,000,000 to the Department of Housing awarded by HUD for the Prairie District Affordable Housing program and,
- \$133,000 private grant funds awarded to the Chicago Department of Health (CDPH) by the Pritzker Pucker Family Foundation for the Crisis Assistance Response and,
- \$200,000 awarded the to CDPH through private grant funds by the National Football League Foundation for Crisis Assistance Response Engagement and,
- \$199,000 awarded to CDPH through State grant funds by the Illinois Department of Public Health for Tobacco Free Communities program and,
- \$5,000 award to the Office of Public Safety Administration through private grant funds by the National Association of VOCA Assistance Administrators for Community Awareness Programs
