
Amounts in Thousands

- The 2023 Budget Recommendation appropriates \$384.4 million to the Department of Water Management ("DWM"), which is an increase of \$37.2 million, or 10.7%, from FY22's revised budget.
- > The appropriation categories driving the FY23 increase are Personnel and Commodities & Materials, which are increasing by \$28.76 million, or 12.6%, and \$15.44 million, or 52.6%, respectively, from the FY22 revised budget.
- The proposed FY23 Budget appropriates 2,483 Full-Time Equivalents (FTEs) to DWM, which is an increase of 291 FTEs compared to FY22.
- The Bureau of Operations & Distribution receives a majority— 52.8%—of DWM's budget in FY23. The Bureau's FY23 budget is \$202.8 million, which is \$28.3 million, or 16.2%, higher than FY22.


