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Pursuant to Chapter 4-60-040(h) of the City of Chicago Municipal Code, the City of Chicago Local Liquor Control Commission (LLCC) and Licensee have agreed to the issuance of a COP-IA Liquor License, Public Place of Amusement License, and Retail Food License ("Licenses") under the following conditions:

- 1. Security Camera System. Licensee shall install a security camera system capable of recording all activity within the areas of the Premises open to the public and at the entrance to the Premises. Licensee shall maintain all recordings for a period of at least ten (10) days, and upon request, shall provide said recordings to the Chicago Police Department ("CPD").
- 2. Cooperation with Police. Licensee agrees that in the event the LLCC or CPD receives a complaint concerning Licensee's operations, Licensee shall cooperate fully with any investigation arising from such complaint, including, but not limited to, submitting any records requested by the LLCC or CPD.
- 3. Reporting Illegal Activity. Licensee shall immediately report any illegal activity observed in and around the Premises to CPD and shall maintain a logbook of all illegal activity reported.
- 4. Third-Party Promoters. Licensee shall not employ or use so-called "promoters" or unlicensed persons or entities to market or promote any entertainment activities conducted at the Premise. Licensee shall not rent the Premises to any such promoter, or allow any event to take place where Licensee vacates the Premises and allows a third-party to hire their own staff (bartenders, servers, hosts and security). All entertainment offered at the Premises shall be booked by Licensee.
- 5. Special Events. Licensee shall notify CPD one week prior to any special events held at the Premises.



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- 6. Cover Charge. Licensee shall not charge any fee or "cover charge" for entry into the Premises.
- 7. Noise Ordinance. Licensee shall comply with all applicable provisions of the Chicago Noise and Vibration Control Ordinance, Chapter 8-32 of the Municipal Code of Chicago.
- **8.** Required Signage. Licensee shall display a sign in a conspicuous location near the front door inside the Premises that reads, "Please Respect Our Neighbors, Exit Quietly and Do Not Loiter."
- 9. Alcohol Server Training. All bartenders and wait staff shall be BASSET or TIPS certified, and trained with respect to the detection of fraudulent identification. All bartenders and wait staff will be trained to identify intoxicated patrons and shall take pro-active steps to prevent the intoxication of patrons.
- 10. Security and ID Scanner. On Fridays and Saturdays nights, Licensee shall have security staff on duty starting at 7:00 p.m. until closing. During such time, the security staff shall make use of an identification scanner to help prevent the sale of alcohol to minors. The security staff shall wear clothing prominently inscribed with the word "Security".
- 11. Package Goods Sales. Licensee shall not sell package goods for off-premises consumption.
- **12. Food Service**. Licensee shall offer food preparation and service to its patrons until at least thirty (30) minutes prior to closing time.
- 13. Meetings. Licensee shall, upon request, attend meetings with the Alderman, CPD, and community residents to discuss any concerns regarding the operation of the Premises.
- **14. Non-Smoking Laws**. Licensee shall enforce all applicable City and State laws prohibiting smoking as they relate to both the interior and the exterior of the Premises.
- **15. Modification of Plan.** Licensee agrees that this Plan of Operation cannot be modified or amended without input by the local Alderman and CPD.

The conditions of this Plan of Operation are legally binding and may be enforced by the City of Chicago enforcement authorities. All other conditions of the Licenses are governed by the City of Chicago Municipal Code ("Code"). Violation of the Plan of Operation or the Code may result in the imposition of a fine and/or suspension or revocation of the Licenses or in the issuance of cease and desist orders prohibiting the activity which violates the Plan of Operation or the Code.



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This Plan of Operation shall apply to the Premises and Licensee and to all officers, managers, partners, and direct or indirect owners of Licensee. The sale of the business to other persons purchasing the membership units of Licensee does not void the Plan of Operation. Any and all potential new owners of Licensee shall be subject to the Plan of Operation.

It shall be the duty of every person conducting, engaging in, maintaining, operating, carry on or managing Licensee to post this Plan of Operation next to the Licenses in a conspicuous place at the Premises.
