LIQUOR LICENSE PLAN OF OPERATION

Pursuant to the City of Chicago Municipal Code Sections 4-156-311 (d)(3)(A) and 4-60-040(h), the City of Chicago Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection, the Local Liquor Control Commission (BACP/LLCC) and the above named Licensee have agreed to the issuance of the Public Place of Amusement (PPA) and Consumption on Premises – Incidental Activity (COP-IA) licenses under the following conditions:

1. The Licensee agrees to use the PPA under the following conditions:

A. Primarily to operate a game room in the basement of the Premises;

B. Licensee shall not operate as a nightclub or dance club;

C. Licensee agrees to always close the windows to the premises each night by 10:00 p.m. and anytime there is live music.

2. Licensee shall regularly monitor the exterior area around the Premises during operating hours to abate noise, loitering and littering caused by Licensee's patrons or employees. Garbage shall be picked up by a private waste management company on a regular basis.

3. Licensee agrees that in the event BACP or the LLCC receives a complaint, the Licensee shall cooperate fully with any investigation, including but not limited to, submitting any records requested by BACP or the LLCC. Licensee shall, upon request of BACP or the LLCC, produce any records requested within 10 days of such request.

4. Licensee shall immediately address any public nuisance issues that impact the health, safety and welfare of the community. Licensee will name a public liaison representative to serve as the agent of the Licensee to members of the community who will hear all complaints filed by the community and seek to resolve any public nuisance matters.

5. Licensee agrees not to expand the Premises without, first, applying to the City of Chicago for the right to expand the Premises.

6. Licensee shall immediately notify the Police of any illegal activity viewed in and around the Premises.

7. Licensee will display a sign in a conspicuous location near the front door inside the Premises that reads, "Please Respect our Neighbors, Please Exit Quietly and Do Not Loiter."

8. Alcohol Server Training. All bar staff will be BASSET or TIPS certified, and will be trained with respect to the detection of fraudulent identification. All bartenders and wait staff will be trained to identify intoxicated patrons and will take pro-active steps to prevent the intoxication of patrons.

9. Licensee shall attend local CAPS Beat meetings and CAPS hospitality meetings when needed and agrees to schedule and/or attend meetings with the alderman, police commander, and community residents or groups to discuss any concerns regarding the operation of the Premises.

10. Non-Smoking Laws. Licensee will enforce all applicable City and State non-smoking laws as they relate to both the interior and the exterior of the Premises.

11. Licensee agrees that this Plan of Operation may not be modified or amended without input by the local alderman.

The agreed conditions of this Plan of Operation are legally binding and may be enforced by City of Chicago enforcement authorities under Section 4-60-040(h) and 4-156-311 (d)(3)(A) of the City of Chicago Municipal Code. All other conditions of the license are governed by the City of Chicago Municipal Code. Violation of the above stated agreed conditions may result in the imposition of a fine and/or suspension or revocation of all business licenses issued to Licensee. Violation of the above stated conditions may also result in the issuance of Cease and Desist Orders prohibiting the activity which violates the conditions of this Plan of Operation.

The agreed conditions of this Plan of Operation shall apply to the Premises and Licensee and to all officers, managers, members, partners and direct or indirect owners of the entity of which is licensed. The sale of the business to other persons purchasing the stock of the licensed entity does not void the conditions of this Plan of Operation. Any and all potential new owners of the licensed entity shall be subject to the same agreed conditions set forth in this Plan of Operation.
