Pursuant to Chapter 4-60-040(h) of the City of Chicago Municipal Code ("Municipal Code"), the City of Chicago Local Liquor Control Commission (LLCC) and the above named Licensee have agreed to the issuance of the above-referenced Licenses under the following conditions:

- 1. The hours for liquor sales shall be: Monday thru Saturday: 7:00 a.m. 11 p.m. and Sunday: 11 a.m. 11p.m.
- 2. The licensee will place a hard stop on all registers during the period of time that liquor sales are prohibited.
- 3. The licensee will be staffed with dedicated assets protection team members. Each team member will receive sufficient training that covers topics such as but not limited to, Investigative Tactics, Incident Response and Documentation, Physical Security Standards and Prevention. Also, Target will have additional Field Leadership support as needed to resolve incidents as quickly as possible.
- 4. The licensee will have the ability to electronically monitor both the interior and exterior of building.
- 5. The licensee will ensure adequate lighting on the exterior of the building is maintained.
- 6. Sufficient camera coverage will be provided to monitor select portions of the exterior and the interior of the building.
- 7. During store operating hours, Target will maintain the exterior of the building in partnership with 3rd party cleaning crews.
- 8. The licensee agrees not to sell any single serve units of beer or ale with a capacity of more than 24 ounces, with the exception of high-end craft beer.



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- 9. The licensee agrees not to sell fortified wines including, but not limited to, Wild Irish Rose, Night Train, Italian Swiss, Gallo, Taylor Port and White port, MD20/20, Cisco, Cool Breeze, Thunderbird, Sunset Grain Alcohol, Seagram's Spritzer and other such products.
- 10. The licensee agrees to not sell all high-gravity malt liquors, including, but not limited to, St. Ives, Steel Reserve 211, Colt 45, Sparks, Joose, Schlitz, Axe Head, Camo Black, Cobra, or KoKoloko and malt beverage products in "single serve" 40 ounce containers.
- 11. Licensee agrees to set up meetings with the local alderman, police commander and community residents to discuss any problematic concerns regarding the operation of the business.

The conditions of these Licenses issued pursuant to this Plan of Operation are legally binding and may be enforced by the City of Chicago enforcement authorities. All other conditions of the Licenses are governed by the City of Chicago Municipal Code. Violation of the above stated conditions may result in the imposition of a fine and/or suspension or revocation of all business licenses issued to the Licensee. Violation of the above stated conditions may also result in the issuance of cease and desist orders prohibiting the activity which violates the conditions of the licenses.

The conditions of these Licenses issued pursuant to this Plan of Operation shall apply to the business address and Licensee and to all officers, managers, partners, and direct or indirect owners of the licensed entity. The sale of the business to other persons purchasing the stock or membership units of the licensed entity does not void the conditions of the Licenses. Any and all potential new owners of the licensed entity shall be subject to the same conditions set forth in this statement.



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It shall be the duty of every person conducting, engaging in, maintaining, operating, carry on or managing the above mentioned business entity to post this Plan of Operation next to the licenses in a conspicuous place at the Premises.
