Pursuant to City of Chicago Municipal Code ("M.C.C.") Section 4-60-040 (h), the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection ("BACP") / Local Liquor Control Commission ("LLCC") of the City of Chicago and the above-named Licensee have agreed to the issuance of a Package Goods, Retail Food Establishment, and Tobacco licenses (collectively "Licenses") under the following conditions:

1. Licensee agrees that the business shall operate and otherwise be open to the public for business during the following hours:

Sunday 11am -12am Monday-Saturday 6am-12am (package goods liquor sales starting at 7:00 a.m.)

- 2. Licensee shall attempt to restrict all deliveries to between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
- 3. Licensee shall immediately address any public nuisance issues which adversely impact the health, safety, and welfare of the community.
- 4. Licensee shall immediately notify, by calling 911, the Police of any illegal activity which it views in and around the Premises.
- 5. Licensee shall maintain a logbook of all illegal activity reported or required to be reported to the Chicago Police Department, as required under Section 4-60-141 of the Chicago Municipal Code.

- 6. The Licensee shall have one (1) security guard on premises between 5:00 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. on the licensed premises, 7 days a week.
- 7. Licensee agrees that in the event the LLCC receives a complaint, the Licensee shall cooperate fully with any investigation, including, but not limited to, submitting any records requested by the LLCC. The Licensee shall, upon request of the LLCC, produce any records of the LLCC has requested within ten (10) days of such request.
- 8. Licensee shall install a professional security system such as ADT as well as multiple cameras that will record and store up to 10 days. The cameras will be strategically placed throughout the interior of the space. Recordings shall be made available to CPD upon request.
- Licensee shall submit any new outdoor signage and/or canopies to the local alderman for approval before installing. Licensee must have City Council approval for any sign or canopy over the public way.
- 10. Licensee agrees to have a land line phone to use for calls to the police or emergency services.
- 11. Licensee agrees that this plan of operation cannot be modified or amended without input by the local Alderman.

The conditions of this liquor license are legally binding and may be enforced by City of Chicago enforcement authorities under M.C.C. §§ 4-60-040(h). All other conditions of the license are governed by the City of Chicago Municipal Code. Violation of the above stated conditions may result in the imposition of a fine and/or suspension or revocation of all business licenses issued to the Licensee. Violations of the above stated conditions may also result in the issuance of cease and desist orders prohibiting the activity which violates the conditions of the liquor license.

The conditions of the business licenses issued pursuant to this Plan of Operation shall apply to the business address and Licensee and to all officers, managers, members, partners and direct or indirect owners of the entity of which is licensed. The sale of the Licensee to other persons purchasing the stock of the licensed entity shall be subject to the same conditions set forth in this Plan of Operation. Any and all potential new owners of the licensed entity shall be subject to the same conditions set forth in this Plan of Operation.

It shall be the duty of every person conducting, engaging in, operating, carrying on or managing the above-mentioned business entity to post this Business License Plan of Operation next to the business license certificates in a conspicuous place at the business address.
