LICENSE PLAN OF OPERATION

The City of Chicago Department of Business Affairs (BACP), the Local Liquor Commissioner, and the above-named licensee have agreed to the following license conditions concerning the issuance and operation of the business:

1. The Licensee shall take proactive steps to prevent loitering inside and outside of the business. This shall include having staff routinely monitor the business inside and outside and to report any loitering to the Chicago police Department.
2. The Licensee shall call or have his staff call 911 if illegal activity occurs inside or within sight of the business. The Licensee shall cooperate with the police by signing complaints against any offenders and attending court hearings.
3. The Licensee will not sell spirits in a container from their distributor in a quantity less than 750 mL per unit or spirits less than \$12.50.
4. Restricted Sales: The Licensee agrees not to sell, order or stock any of the following liquors, non-liquors, and tobacco products:
  - a. Fortified Wines: Wild Irish Rose, Night Train, Italian Swiss, Gallo, Taylor Port and White Port, MD 20/20, Cisco, Cook Breeze, Thunderbird, Sunset Grain Alcohol, Seagram's Spritzer and other such fortified wine brands.
  - b. Special Brews: All High-gravity malt liquors, St. Ives, Steel Reserve 211, Colt 45, Sparks, Juose, Schlitz, Axe Head, Camo Black, Cobra, or KoKoloko.

5. The Licensee shall refrain from selling cheap 1/2 pints of distilled liquor (liquor selling for less than \$5.00).
6. The Licensee shall refrain from selling malt liquor, including but not limited to, special brews such as All High-gravity malt liquors: St. Ives, Steel Reserve 211, Colt 45, Sparks, Juose, Schlitz, Axe Head, CamoBlack, Cobra, KoKoloko or other products sold in containers resembling liquor bottles or fruit flavored alcoholic beverages to anyone under the age of 21 years.
7. The Licensee shall submit any outdoor signage and/or canopies to the local alderman for approval before installing. The Licensee must have City Council approval for any sign or canopy over the public way.
8. The Licensee shall close his business at or before 12:00 am on Monday through Sunday.
9. Outdoor Lighting- Managed by Planned Property Management.
10. Garbage Disposal Program- Maintained by Planned Property Management.


The agreed conditions of the License Plan of Operation are legally binding and may be enforced by City of Chicago enforcement authorities. Violations of the above-stated agreed conditions may result in the imposition of a fine and / or suspension or revocation of all business licenses issued to the licensee. Violations of the above-stated agreed conditions may also result in the issuance of cease and desist orders prohibiting the activity which violates the conditions of the liquor license.

The agreed conditions of the License Plan of Operation shall apply to the business address and licensee and to all officers, managers, members, partners and direct or indirect owners of the entity which is licensed. The sale of the business to other persons purchasing the stock of the licensed entity shall be subject to the same agreed conditions set forth in this plan of operation.

It shall be the duty of every person conducting, engaging in, operating, carrying on, or managing the above-mentioned business entity to post this License Plan of Operation next to the business license certificates in a conspicuous place at the business address.
