Pursuant to Chapter 4-60-040(h) of the City of Chicago Municipal Code, the City of Chicago Local Liquor Control Commission (LLCC) and the above named Licensee have agreed to the issuance of a Retail Food Establishment and a Liquor – Consumption on Premises – Incidental Activity license under the following conditions:

- 1. Licensee will operate during the following hours: Sunday, Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Friday and Saturday from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., and closed on Tuesday.
- 2. Licensee will operate a restaurant on the premises whose primary business activity will be the sale and service of food and where alcohol sales and consumption of alcohol will only be incidental to food service. Licensee is prohibited from having any PPA (Public Place of Amusement) activity on the premises without the appropriate license. Licensee shall not charge for any amusement activities.
- 3. Licensee agrees to train all staff who may serve alcoholic beverages with BASSET or TIPS training and that all staff is certified in this training. License agrees that new employees will be BASSET or TIPS trained and certified within two weeks (2) of their employment. Employees will also be trained in fraudulent ID detection.
- 4. Licensee will monitor the area in and around the licensed premises and guard against the service of alcohol to minors and assure that patron do not leave the premises with open alcohol. Licensee will not permit any patron to consume alcohol outside the premises.
- 5. Licensee will monitor the area around the business and the nearby area from open to close and keep it clean, free of garbage and debris. Garbage will be picked up by a private scavenger service. The licensee will utilized an industrial lock service and remove all city garbage and recycling bins.

- 6. Licensee will immediately contact the police if any illegal activity occurs.
- 7. Licensee agrees to monitor the outside of the premises to alleviate any traffic, parking or noise issues.
- 8. Licensee agrees to immediately address public nuisance issues brought by community residents, police or the local alderman.

The Licensee acknowledges that (i) the conditions outlined in this Plan of Operation are legally binding and may be enforced by the City of Chicago enforcement authorities under MCC 4-60-040. All other conditions of the licenses issued to the Licensee are governed by the City of Chicago Municipal Code, (ii) violation of the above stated conditions may result in the imposition of a fine and/or suspension or revocation of all business licenses issued to the Licensee, (iii) violation of the above stated conditions may also result in the issuance of a cease and desist order prohibiting the activity which violates the conditions of the liquor license, (iv) the conditions of the liquor licenses issued pursuant to this Plan of Operation shall apply to the business address and Licensee and to all officers, managers, partners, and owners of the licensed entity, (v) the sale of the business to other persons purchasing the stock or membership units of the licensed entity does not void the conditions of the license, (vi) any and all potential new owners of the licensed entity shall be subject to the same conditions set forth herein, (vii) it shall be the duty of every person conducting, engaging in, maintaining, operating, carrying on or managing the Licensee to post this Plan of Operation next to the liquor license, issued to the Licensee in a conspicuous place at the business address.
