Per Chapter 4-60-040(h), of the City of Chicago Municipal Code, the Local Liquor Control Commission has authorized the issuance of a Packaged Goods license to the above-named business entity and business location under the following conditions:

- 1. <u>Hours of Operation:</u> The Licensee shall operate the store Monday through Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. and on Sunday from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.
- Security Cameras. The Licensee agrees to have a security camera system that will cover the inside and outside of the store with a recording device for viewing of all recordings. Such cameras shall be able to record discernable images from a minimum distance of 15 feet in front of and on the sides of any business entrance. Licensee shall maintain such cameras and tapes or vides for a minimum of 30-days and make such recordings immediately available upon request of any City of Chicago agency.
- Security Guards. The Licensee agrees to have two (2) security employed at the premises seven (7) days a week from the hours of 4:00 p.m. until closing. Licensee agrees to have security patrol the interior and exterior of the premises. Security shall monitor the area in and around the licensed premises and guard against the service of alcohol to minors.

- <u>Cooperation with the City of Chicago Police Department</u>. The Licensee, or a representative, agrees to regularly attend C.A.P.S. meetings to address any crime concerns or problems within the neighborhood and will cooperate with local police to prevent crime.
- Incident Monitoring and Reporting. The Licensee shall maintain a log documenting any incidents or possible unlawful activity in or outside the licensed premises, and the licensee will immediately contact the police if any illegal activity occurs inside or outside the licensed premises.
- Legal Identification Program. Licensee agrees to have the licensee and all employees certified in alcohol servers training class such as BASSETT or TIPS and will ask all patrons to submit proper forms of legal identification prior to selling any packaged goods liquor or tobacco.
- Signage. The Licensee agrees to place in a conspicuous and prominent location reminding patrons to not cause undue noise or loitering in the community and to respect the neighborhood.
- Garbage Disposal. The Licensee agrees to have all trash picked up on a regular basis and adhere strictly to all City of Chicago ordinances concerning litter and garbage.
- <u>Community Participation</u>. The Licensee agrees to work with the local alderman, city agencies and any community groups to address any negative quality of life issues with the operation of the business.

The conditions of the Package Goods Liquor License issued pursuant to this Plan of Operation are legally binding and may be enforced by the City of Chicago enforcement authorities under Section 4-60-040 (h) of the City of Chicago Municipal Code. All other conditions of the license are governed by the City of Chicago Municipal Code. Violation of the above stated conditions may result in the imposition of a fine and/or suspension or revocation of all business licenses issued to the Licensee. Violation of the above stated conditions may also result in the issuance of Cease and Desist Orders prohibiting the activity which violates the conditions of the liquor license.

The conditions of the Package Goods license issued pursuant to this Plan of Operation shall apply to the business address and License and to all officers, managers, partners, and direct or indirect owners of the licensed entity. The sale of the business to other persons purchasing the stock or membership units of the licensed entity does not void the conditions of the license. Any and all potential new owners of the licensed entity shall be subject to the same conditions set forth in this Plan of Operation.

It shall be the duty of every person conducting, engaging in, maintaining, operating, carrying on or managing the above mentioned business entity to post this Package Goods license plan of operation next to the Package Goods license in a conspicuous place at the business address.
