Mobile Food Vehicle Agreed Plan of Operation

Licensee: Olmar Corporation, Inc. / CPG Food Truck, LLC.

The City of Chicago Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the above named licensee have agreed to the following license conditions concerning the operation of the licensee's mobile food vehicle:


1. Licensee agrees that its Mobile Food Vehicle operator(s) shall repeat the Fire Safety Class.
2. Licensee agrees that a person who has successfully completed a Fire Safety Class conducted by the Chicago Fire Department - Fire Prevention Bureau shall be present at all times while the MFV is in operation.
3. Licensee agrees that it shall not carry more than forty (40) pounds of propane at one time on its mobile food vehicle (MFV), and that the propane gas tanks used shall be in compliance with the Chicago Board of Health Rules and Regulations for Mobile Food Vehicles Rule 4(A)(2).
4. Licensee agrees that it will properly mount and place propane tanks on its MFV in accordance with the Chicago Board of Health Rules and Regulations for Mobile Food Vehicles Rule 4(A)(4).
5. Licensee agrees that at all times while operating its MFV Licensee shall maintain a valid and current MFV Fire Safety Permit.
6. Licensee agrees that it shall have present at all times at its MFV a person possessing a Chicago Fire Department-approved propane handling certification, in accordance with the Chicago Board of Health Rules and Regulations for Mobile Food Vehicles Rule 5(A)(4).
7. Licensee agrees to remain in continual compliance with Chicago Fire Department regulations governing the use of propane and uphold the terms of the MFV's fire safety permit.
8. Licensee agrees that it shall comply with all requirements for Mobile Food Vehicle operations.

This License Plan of Operation has been drafted in lieu of the BACP filing a license revocation case as a result of incidences where the licensee violated the Mobile Food Vehicles Rules, as cited in case 15 LR 209.

The agreed conditions herein are legally binding and may be enforced by the City of Chicago enforcement authorities. Violation of the above stated agreed conditions may result in the imposition of a fine and/or suspension or revocation of the mobile food vehicle license issued to the to the licensee. Violations of the above stated agreed conditions may also result in the issuance of cease and desist order prohibiting the activity which violates the conditions of the agreement herein. The conditions imposed pursuant to this plan of operation shall apply to the Licensee and to all officers, managers, partners and direct or indirect owners of the licensed entity. The sale of the business to other persons purchasing the stock or membership units of the licensed entity does not void the above conditions on the license. Any and all potential new owners of the licensed entity shall be subject to the same conditions set forth in this plan of operation.
