## RENEWAL NOTICE FOR LICENSES EXTENDED DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Be advised that all licenses issued by the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection ("BACP") under Title 4 or Title 9 of the Municipal Code of Chicago ("MCC") that were extended temporarily due to the COVID-19 pandemic will expire on July 15, 2021. Impacted licenses with an expiration date between March 15, 2020, and June 15, 2021 that were extended during the COVID-19 pandemic must be renewed by July 15, 2021 in order to continue legal operations in Chicago.

Impacted licensees are expected to comply with required license fees in order to renew. License renewal fees can be found in [Chapter 4-5 of the MCC](#). Business licensees can renew online via [chicagobusinessdirect.org](http://chicagobusinessdirect.org).
