STAY HOME SAVE LIVES

Effective April 9, 2020, all liquor sales are now prohibited after 9 p.m. until further notice in the City of Chicago.

To stop the spread of COVID-19 and protect Chicago's communities, the City of Chicago has implemented the following change to the Municipal Code to discourage congregating ("gathering") inside and outside of all establishments and ensure social distancing.

Under Code Section 4-60-130, every establishment licensed under Chapter 4-60 of the Code shall cease all sales of alcoholic liquor between 9 p.m. and the hour at which the licensee is permitted to resume alcoholic liquor sales.
