**APPROVED WAV TAXI VOUCHER PROGRAM VENDORS**  
**Updated April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

To help increase and support the City of Chicago's wheelchair-accessible taxi fleet, the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection (BACP) is providing incentive funding through the **Wheelchair-Accessible Taxi Voucher Program ("Program")**. The Program provides incentives toward the purchase of an eligible "*factory-built*" Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle ("WAV") or the cost of "*conversion*" of a conventional vehicle by a City-approved taxi conversion company.

- A factory-built (vehicle manufactured originally as a WAV) WAV is eligible for up to **\$35,000**.
- A converted (post-manufacture mechanical conversion/modification of a brand new vehicle) WAV is eligible for up to **\$25,000**.
