



Public Chauffeur Courses at Olive-Harvey College

LIMOUSINE (Restricted Public Chauffeur) | \$115

The Limousine–Restricted Chauffeur Training Certificate Program is an intensive one-day preparatory course to assist individuals with the successful completion of the restricted public chauffeur’s license exam. Students learn current chauffeur rules and regulations, as well as information on new cultural attractions, buildings, hospitals and hotels.

TAXI (Unrestricted Public Chauffeur) | \$305

The Taxi - Unrestricted Public Passenger Vehicle Training Program is designed to prepare individuals to become public chauffeurs in the City of Chicago and to take the License examination. This 5-day comprehensive training program covers Chicago geography/navigation, departmental rules and regulations, accessibility training, and professional development.

PROFESSIONALISM/REFUSAL OF SERVICE | \$85

This one-day, 6-hour course is for licensed public chauffeurs who have been directed by the Business Affairs and Consumer Protection department to take a corrective training course.

TAP (Taxi Access Program) | \$85

This is a six-hour training session on how to serve passengers with disabilities and the Taxi Access Program (TAP).

4 HOUR DEFENSIVE DRIVING | \$45

This four-hour course is designed as an abbreviated yet engaging course reinforcing good driving skills and habits. This course offers practical strategies to reduce collision-related injuries, fatalities and costs associated with motor vehicle crashes.

8 HOUR ATTITUDINAL DEFENSIVE DRIVING | \$85

This eight-hour course is designed for drivers who have a record of rules and regulations violations. Course reviews violated rules and regulations, anger management, conflict resolutions training, defensive driving and a behavior modification approaches.
