Taxi Access Program – Accessibility Training

This is a twelve-hour training session, over two (2) days for industry professionals on how to transport persons with disabilities, and how to use the PACE-TAP voucher system to ensure payments. Using a replica of the actual van used in transporting persons with disabilities, students are given hands-on instructions in handling and securing wheelchairs. Morning and Afternoon classes are available beginning on Thursdays, excluding holidays.

The Basic Certificate Program for Public Passenger Vehicle Training: Taxi is designed to prepare individuals to become public chauffeurs in the City of Chicago and to take the Public Chauffeur License examination issued by the Chicago Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection. This two-week comprehensive training program covers Chicago geography/navigation, departmental rules and regulations, accessibility training, and professional development.

4 Hour – Defensive Driving

This course is designed as an abbreviated yet engaging course reinforcing good driving skills and habits. This course offers practical strategies to reduce collision-related injuries, fatalities and costs associated with motor vehicle crashes. car insurance companies may provide discount for class completion, check with your local agency for details

8 Hour – Attitudinal Defensive Driving

This course is designed for drivers and licensed chauffeurs who have a record of rules and regulations violations. Topics include a review of violated rules and regulations, cultural sensitivity training, anger management, conflict resolutions training, defensive driving and a behavior modification approach to effective customer service. This course also reviews the Illinois Rules of the Road hand book and prepares the inexperienced driver for the road. Writing assignments, as appropriate to the discipline, are part of the course.
