Transportation Network Provider (TNP) Vehicle Inspections **END OF EXTENDED VEHICLE INSPECTION PERIOD**

Effective November 1, 2022, the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection (BACP) will end the six-month extension for the TNP vehicle annual inspection.

During the initial height of the COVID-19 pandemic, BACP extended the requirement time period for vehicle inspections from 12 months to 18 months. That extension will terminate on November 1, 2022.

All affiliated TNP vehicles must comply fully with Section 9-115-110(a) of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago (MCC) by submitting to and passing an annual vehicle inspection. Results of the annual inspection must be submitted to the TNP company to which the vehicle is affiliated. TNP companies and TNP drivers may be held jointly and severally liable for any violations of Section 9-115-110(a) MCC.

For reference, MCC § 9-115-110(a) states:

No transportation network provider licensee shall allow any vehicle to be used as a transportation network vehicle unless such vehicle is annually inspected according to standards approved by the Commissioner and has passed such inspection.

The City of Chicago's Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection (BACP) ensures Chicago's public passenger vehicles are safe, reliable and provide residents and visitors positive transportation options. BACP is committed to providing accessibility for all individuals, including people with disabilities.
