PUBLIC PASSENGER VEHICLE OPERATIONS

The Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection (BACP), in support of the City of Chicago's efforts to minimize the transmission of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), is implementing the following protocols.

Effective March 19, 2020, BACP offices are closed to the public due to the health and safety recommendations by experts endorsing social distancing efforts. BACP will send out a future notice with information on when BACP offices will reopen to the public.

BACP staff will continue to work servicing public passenger vehicle licensees during closure to the public. BACP staff will be available by e-mail and phone.

I. PUBLIC PASSENGER VEHICLE LICENSE RENEWALS

Renewal of the following public passenger vehicle licenses <u>will be deferred</u> <u>until April 30, 2020</u>:

- Public Chauffeur (taxicab, livery, pedicab, and horse drawn carriage drivers) Licenses with expiration dates between February 1, 2020 and March 31, 2020.
- Pedicab Vehicle Licenses expiring March 31, 2020. Licensees are encouraged to submit license renewal documents directly to <u>BACPPV@cityofchicago.org</u>.
- Transportation Network Provider Licenses expiring March 31, 2020. Licensees are encouraged to submit license renewal documents directly to <u>BACPPV@cityofchicago.org</u>.
- Taxicab Medallion Licenses that expired February 29, 2020. Licensees are encouraged to submit license renewal documents directly to <u>BACPPV@cityofchicago.org</u>.

► If applicable, BACP encourages licensees to submit licensing documents to <u>BACPPV@cityofchicago.org</u> to perform license renewals remotely.

II. PUBLIC PASSENGER VEHICLE INSPECTIONS

Public vehicle inspections scheduled at the BACP Public Vehicle Inspection Facility (2420 W. Pershing Road/ 39^{th} Street) from March 19, 2020 to March 31, 2020 will be rescheduled.

An updated Public Vehicle Inspection Schedule will be posted at the BACP webpage at Chicago.Gov/BACP. BACP shall notify taxicab affiliations and license managers by e-mail of updated public vehicle inspection dates.

III. SURRENDERING TAXICAB MEDALLION LICENSES

Taxicab medallion licensees surrendering licenses may mail (e-mail or U.S. Mail) completed License Surrender forms. A License Surrender form is available to download at the BACP webpage.
