## Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection Remote Adjudication of Administrative Notices of Violation (ANOVs)

The City of Chicago's Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection (BACP) has set up a new option to attempt to resolve outstanding citations without requiring a visit to the Department of Administrative Hearings, 400 W. Superior. This remote adjudication option will be available during the ongoing COVID-19 crisis in an effort to help protect the health and safety of people in Chicago.

Anyone who has been issued an Administrative Notice of Violation (ANOV) that is scheduled for a hearing in Room 106 or Room 107 at the Department of Administrative Hearings, 400 West Superior, may attempt to resolve their matter remotely.

If you would like to attempt to resolve your ANOV without an in-person Administrative Hearing, please send an email to **BACP-AdministrativeHearings@CityofChicago.org** and include the following information:

- Name,
- Telephone number,
- Violation address,
- Citation number(s),
- · Court room number, and
- Hearing date.

Alternatively, you may attach a scanned copy of the ANOV(s) you received to your email. Once this information is received, BACP staff will review it and reach out to you to discuss the ANOV and how it can be resolved.

Please note that sending this information to BACP does not require you to resolve the violation through this process. An in-person hearing at the Department of Administrative Hearings will remain an option when that department reopens.
