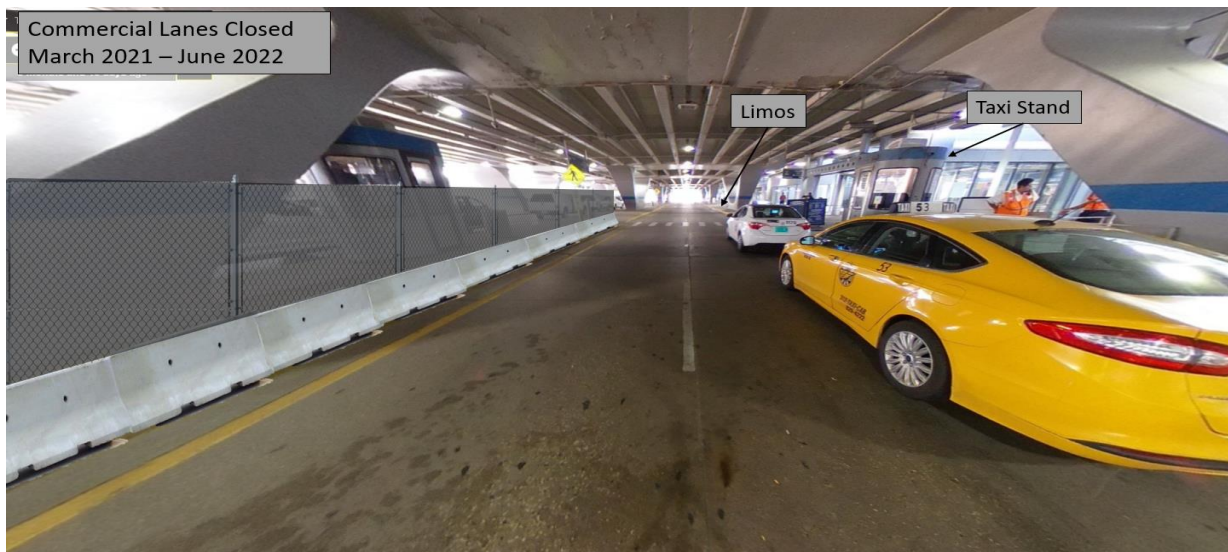
O'Hare Airport Ground Transportation Notice

Chicago Department of Aviation will continue construction at O'Hare International Airport of the middle commercial lane for 14 months at the lower-level roadway of Terminals 1, 2, 3.

Phase I construction will begin night of March 30th and scheduled for completion until June 2022. This means that City Taxi, Suburban Taxi, non-stretch limos and deliveries will all share the inner lane until the middle lane construction is completed in June 2022.

Various crosswalks will close at different stages on the inner lane. Vehicles will enter the terminals utilizing the regular entry points. No other government or commercial vehicles should park in the inner lane of the lower levels during construction.

Use caution while driving during this critical construction project! Thank you for your patience as CDA redevelops these areas as part of the O'Hare 21 Program.
