FACE COVERINGS ARE STILL REQUIRED IN:

- **PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**
- **CITY OF CHICAGO BUILDINGS,
including BACP Offices**

REMINDER:

**All public chauffeurs and passengers
are required to wear masks/face**

coverings while transporting passengers in public passenger vehicles

(taxicabs, transportation network or ride-hail vehicles, liveries, tour boats, charter-sightseeing vehicles, etc.)

**All visitors are required to wear a face covering in City of Chicago
buildings, offices, and facilities.**

Recipients of COVID-19 vaccinations are NOT exempt from wearing face coverings as required IN PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION or INSIDE CITY of CHICAGO BUILDINGS.
