## WAV TAXICAB DRIVER LEASE SUBSIDY REMINDERS

As stated on the "<u>WAV Taxicab Driver Lease</u> <u>Subsidy Request Form</u>", WAV Taxicab Driver Lease subsidy requests must be submitted **no later than 6** 

Notice No. 22-009

- months from the lease date to be eligible for funding. Untimely submissions will be denied.
  - Example: February 2022 leases must be submitted no later than August 2022.

## WAV TAXICAB LEASE SUBSIDY INCENTIVE FOR TAXICAB DRIVER LESSEE

Lease agreements qualify for the following incentive amounts\*:

- **\$25** subsidy reimbursement for eligible WAV taxicab drivers per 12-hour lease agreement of a WAV taxicab vehicle.
- **\$50** subsidy reimbursement for eligible WAV taxicab drivers per 24-hour lease agreement of a WAV taxicab vehicle.

\*BACP will review Centralized WAV Taxicab Dispatch (CURB) records, including trip acceptance and rejection data, in evaluating if a WAV taxi driver or WAV taxi is "<u>actively participating and</u> <u>responding</u>". At a minimum, taxi driver lessee applicants for Accessibility Fund incentives must be able to demonstrate being available on the Centralized WAV Taxicab Dispatch platform <u>and</u> complete one trip per leased day. If the WAV cab driver does not meet the criteria, the subsidy request will be denied.
