Updated Wheelchair Accessible Taxi Incentive Subsidy Request Forms

The Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection (BACP) has posted updated Wheelchair Accessible Taxi Subsidy Request Forms at <u>Chicago.gov/PublicVehicles</u> on the "<u>Chicago Wheelchair Accessible Taxicabs</u>" webpage. The following August 1, 2023 updated forms must be completed and submitted by Wheelchair Accessible Taxi Owners and Lease Drivers requesting incentive subsidies. Older versions of the forms will not be accepted.

Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle (WAV) Taxi Incentive Subsidy Request Forms

- <u>WAV Taxicab Driver Lease Subsidy Request Form</u>
- <u>WAV Taxicab Vehicle Maintenance Subsidy Request Form</u>
- <u>WAV Taxi Owner Operator Subsidy Request Form</u>

The forms reflect program updates previously announced which are effective August 1, 2023.

For ALL WAV Taxi subsidy programs, the following qualifications remain:

- ✓ Applicant's license status must be in Good Standing with the City of Chicago;
- ✓ Applicant must not have City of Chicago debt holds; and
- ✓ Applicant must demonstrate active participation in the City of Chicago Centralized WAV Taxi Dispatch Service program by performing the required minimum number of monthly trips requested by persons with disabilities through the City of Chicago Centralized WAV Taxi Dispatch Service contractor - Curb Mobility (<u>gocurb.com/chicagowav</u>)

Qualifying WAV taxi trips must be completed through Curb.

-WAV Taxi License Holder Maintenance Subsidy-

- Supports WAV taxi owners' extra expenses associated with WAV taxis and keeps WAV taxis on the road longer.
- Annual subsidy: up to \$9,000 for qualifying WAV vehicle maintenance expenses.
- Effective August 1, 2023, WAV taxi owner must demonstrate active participation by ensuring the WAV taxi is completing a minimum of 20 (twenty) Centralized WAV Taxi Dispatch Service Program trips per month through Curb.

-WAV Taxi Chauffeur Lease Subsidy-

- Supports the lease expenses of WAV taxi drivers who operate WAV taxis to serve passengers who use wheelchairs.
- Subsidy amount: \$25 per day for 12-hour lease / \$50 per day for 24-hour lease.
- Effective August 1, 2023, WAV taxi driver must demonstrate active participation by performing a minimum of 40 (forty) Centralized WAV Taxi Dispatch trips per month through Curb.

-NEW WAV Taxi Owner-Operator Subsidy-

- Launching August 1, 2023, to support WAV taxi owners who also are the sole driver of the WAV taxi. These individuals are not eligible for the WAV taxi lease subsidy described above.
- Subsidy amount: \$25 per day that WAV taxi owner-operator operates their WAV taxi and demonstrates active participation by performing a minimum of 40 (forty) Centralized WAV Taxi Dispatch trips per month through Curb.
