NEW LICENSE DECALS FOR 2024 EVEN-NUMBERED TAXI LICENSES!

Beginning in 2024, BACP started issuing an adhesive taxi license dashboard decal to be affixed and displayed on the passenger-side dashboard of EVEN-numbered licensed taxi vehicles.



The switch from metal to decal resulted from a May 2023 survey asking the taxi industry to vote to keep or replace the metal medallion plate.

- **85% of survey response voted to REPLACE the metal plate.**
- The new decal eliminates drilling holes in the taxicab hood to affix the metal medallion.
- Using taxi license decals instead of metal plates is a positive sustainability initiative.
- The new decal is visible to the public and enforcement to identify licensed City of Chicago taxis.

Note: the ODD-numbered taxi licenses which renewed in 2023 will continue to display the 2023 issued metal medallion plate on the vehicle hood. In 2025, BACP will issue a dashboard decal for odd-numbered medallion licenses.
