



## 2025 Sueños Fest Transportation Restrictions TNP, Taxi, Charter, Livery, Pedicab, e-scooter, and Divvy Pick-up, drop-off, restrictions, and directives Saturday, May 24, 2025 & Sunday, May 25, 2025 (10:30am – 11:30pm CDT daily)



The Office of Emergency Management and Communications (OEMC), in conjunction with the Chicago Police Department (CPD), requires the following to ensure public safety during Sueños Fest 2025:

- Staging, pick-up, and drop-offs are restricted from Randolph St. to 16th St., DuSable Lake Shore Drive to State St, highlighted in Red on the map.
- TNPs, Taxis, Charters, and Liveries may only <u>pick-up and/or drop-off</u> passengers at the designated points highlighted in <u>Green</u> on the map (except WAV with ADA passengers).
  - O Northeast curb of Michigan Ave at Balbo ADA pick-up and drop-off
  - o 11th / Wabash drop-off and pick-up
  - Millennium Park Garages drop-off, pick-up, and staging
    - From Lower Wacker and N Columbus Dr, head south on N Columbus Dr, take the ramp to Lower Columbus continuing to Lower Randolph, continue straight into the garage, follow the arrows to the TNP area.
- Divvy and e-scooters are restricted (no travel and no park zone) within the area of Monroe to Roosevelt, State to DuSable Lake Shore Drive, highlighted in Yellow on the map
- No vehicles stopping, standing, or parking in bus or bicycle lanes, active traffic lanes, intersections, fire lanes, sidewalk crossings, turning lanes, etc. (Strictly enforced)
- No pick-up or drop-off on DuSable Lake Shore Drive, including on-ramps, off-ramps, medians, turning lanes, shoulders, and emergency pull-off areas. (Strictly enforced)
- No pedicab shall be operated on Michigan Avenue and State Street from Ida B. Wells Drive to Oak Street.
