FOOD TRUCKS AT O'HARE CATER TO CAB DRIVERS!

In response to requests from the Taxicab Industry, Chicago Department of Aviation (CDA) and the Department of Business Affairs & Consumer Protection (BACP) worked for changes in the law to facilitate food trucks to operate in the airport commercial vehicle holding lots.

An ordinance passed in April makes it now feasible for City of Chicago Licensed Food Trucks to operate in the commercial vehicle holding lots.



CDA recently launched a pilot program to enable food trucks to park and serve in the O'Hare airport's commercial vehicle holding lot catering to taxicab drivers.
