## Happy New Year! CACC's 2016 Year in Review

In 2016, the open-admission City shelter worked hand-in-hand with our rescue partners, volunteers, and the public to help more Chicagoans get the animal services they needed, and more animals to find a second chance at a great life. CACC took in more than 15,700 animals in 2016.

### Services

We continued serving customers at our monthly low-cost vaccine and microchip clinics here at the shelter, and assisted at a number of community clinics. We also continued to offer low-cost euthanasia services. Our shelter helped reunite more than 1300 pet owners with their lost pets, and helped more than a thousand people adopt the pet of their dreams. CACC's animal control officers responded to over 40,000 service requests.

### Increased Communication

CACC launched its official CACC Facebook page, and began its monthly Ward newsletters to keep everyone up to speed on animal-related issues, including the importance of micro-chipping pets and how to deal with wildlife nuisances.

### Increased Partnering to Save Lives

CACC worked closely with our rescue partners to transfer more than 7,300 animals from the facility, and broadened its partner network. Safe Humane Chicago expanded its dog training/play group and enrichment programs within the shelter and significantly increased CACC's capacity for care. Friends of Chicago Animal Care and Control donated a digital X-ray machine, and so much more to aid in CACC's care of the animals. The Chicagoland Rescue Intervention and Support Program helped many pet owners keep their pets and helped more than 200 pets find rescue opportunities before entering the shelter. CACC also began conducting general volunteer orientations again!
