Don't Ignore It- Report it!

The Chicago Human Rights Ordinance prohibits discrimination in employment based on:

| Race | Color |
| Sex (including Sexual harassment) | Gender identity |
| Age | Religion |
| National origin | Disability |
| Sexual orientation | Ancestry |
| Parental status | Marital status |
| Criminal history | Military status |
| Source of income | Credit history |

It is a violation of the law to discriminate in:

- Hiring
- Classification
- Grading
- Discharge
- Discipline
- Compensation
- Other terms or conditions of employment

If you believe you have been a victim of employment discrimination, don't ignore it, report it to the CCHR.
