



Employment Discrimination

Don't Ignore It- Report it!

The Chicago Human Rights Ordinance prohibits discrimination in employment based on:

Race	Color
Sex (including Sexual harassment)	Gender identity
Age	Religion
National origin	Disability
Sexual orientation	Ancestry
Parental status	Marital status
Criminal history	Military status
Source of income	Credit history

It is a violation of the law to discriminate in:

- Hiring
- Classification
- Grading
- Discharge
- Discipline
- Compensation
- Other terms or conditions of employment

If you believe you have been a victim of employment discrimination, don't ignore it, report it to the CCHR.
