WHEREAS, DePaul University in Chicago is celebrating the life of Kadri Cakrani and his family through the only Albanian Studies Department in the United States:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, BRANDON JOHNSON, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO, do hereby proclaim November 11, to be KADRI CAKRANI DAY IN CHICAGO in recognition of his strength and perseverance and encourage all Chicagoans to always remember and acknowledge his sacrifices.
