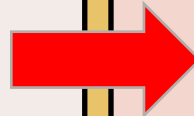

CITY COUNCIL

In July 2021, the Chicago City Council passed an ordinance creating a new model for police oversight, accountability, and public safety. The ordinance creates two bodies:



The Commission

Community Commission for Public Safety and Accountability, with power to advance systemic reform. Play a central role in selecting and removing the Police Superintendent, Police Board members, and the COPA Chief Administrator.

District Councils

District Councils, which was elected in each 22 police district. Our goal is to work to improve policing and public safety in the district.

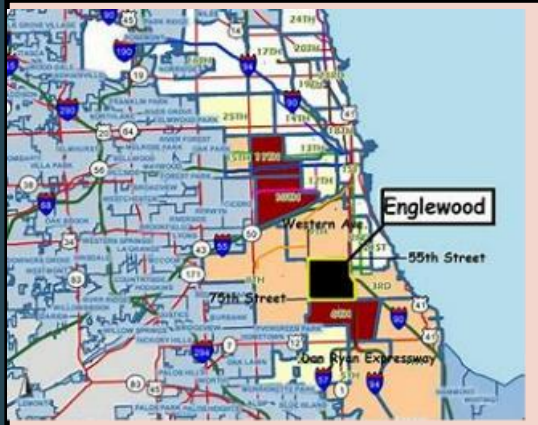

Chair
