District Council Member Updates
The Nominator explained that Community Commission applications were on the city website and encouraged community members to apply. District Council members have submitted a request to the Community Commission to set meetings up with each District Commanders. In the November meeting Impact for Equity spoke about the free to move campaign. This should be revisited to inform the community of pretextual stops. The chairperson mentioned that statistics show that most crime is down but it has been a spike in robberies.
The Community Engagement person expressed that by completing the district survey, it can help the DC's assist the district better.

Discussions
Sharlyn Grace from Pretrial Fairness Act educated the district about how the law works. Sharlyn explained how people didn't have money to bond out so they would have to sit in the county jail until their next court dates for misdemeanor offences. Sharlyn explained that the goal is to not arrest people for misdemeanors unless they pose a threat to public safety. And this is the reason for the new no cash bond system.
