### **GUEST SPEAKERS:**

Commander Bartz Update:

- -SDI Cars staffing coming largely from 018th District officers through OT initiative within the district
- -Commanders have more control over their district and workforce needs starting in Feb
- -Crime trends increase in robberies...people from outside of the district coming to the district
- -CAPS/Educational opportunity and citywide new robbery taskforce initiative

Guest Speaker: Assistant State Attorney Anne McCord Rodgers, Supervisor of First Court, the pretrial Unit of Cook County States Attorney Office

- -Provided extensive description of the changes to pretrial detention process resulting from the Safe T Act
- -explained the crimes that can be considered for detention and those crime that cannot result in detention
- noted the ASA must file request to detain with the judge and then present case for detention, with the judge making the decision of whether to detain
- commented that she personally reviews almost every charge of murder to make sure a proper case is presented for detention
- -noted almost all misdemeanors are non-detainable and retail theft is non detainable
