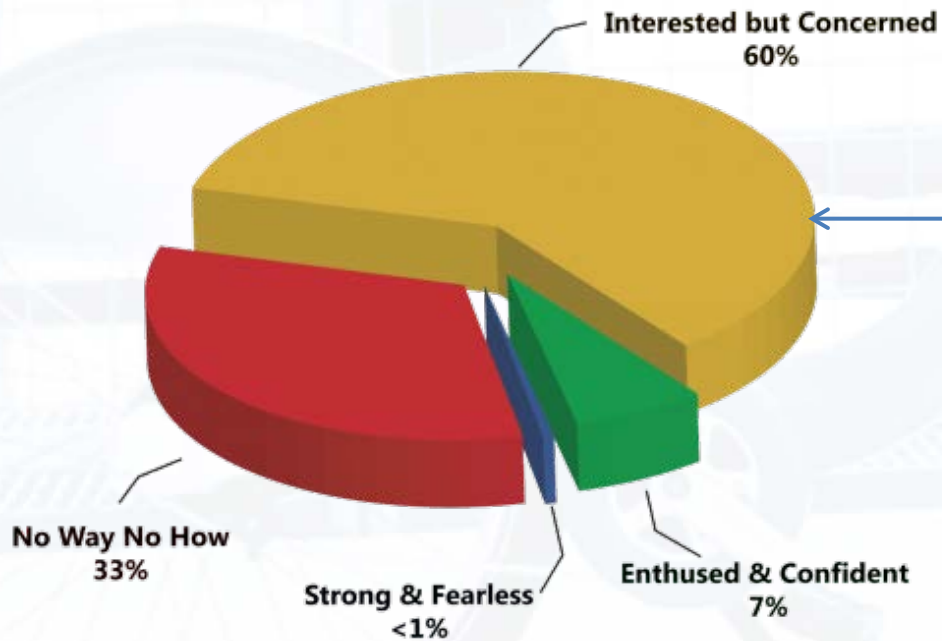

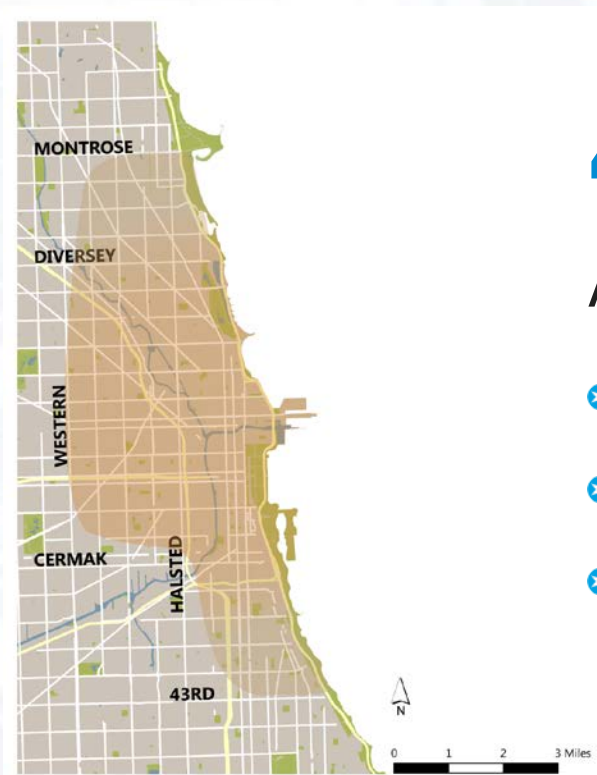

Bike Share in Chicago



4,000 bikes @ **400** stations

Across 14 wards bordered by:

- ★ **Devon** on the NORTH
- ★ **Damen** on the WEST
- ★ **63rd Street** on the SOUTH

Launch begins in Spring 2013

One Size Fits All

Front and rear fenders to protect clothing

Basket holds up to 20lbs; straps to hold loose items

Step through design and chain guard allows riders to wear suits or skirts
