

State St Bascule Bridge and Viaduct Repair


On Monday, April 28, 2025, the Chicago Department of Transportation crews will begin to perform emergency repairs at the State St Bascule Bridge over the main branch of the Chicago River. The repairs will require full closure of the bridge to vehicular, bicycle, and pedestrian traffic, scheduled for Monday, April 28, 2025 through mid-November, 2025.

Scope of Work

The scheduled scope of work involves removing and replacing floor beams and rehabilitating multiple center lock components, concurrently. Additional viaduct repairs north of the bridge to be constructed in two stages.

Traffic Detour and Reroute During Construction

There will be an approximately seventh-month long full closure of the roadway and sidewalks from Monday, April 28, 2025 through mid-November, 2025. During the full closure, all traffic will be detoured as follows:



Pedestrians

Pedestrians may reroute to N Dearborn St or N Wabash Ave.

Bicycles

Bicyclists may reroute to N Dearborn St where a bike lane is present.

Vehicles

Northbound Vehicles: NB State St > WB Wacker Dr > NB Dearborn St > EB Kinzie St > NB State St

Southbound Vehicles: SB N State St > WB Kinzie St > SB Clark St > EB Wacker Dr > SB State St
