The Chicago Public Health Department (CDPH) is hosting a community meeting about the Metal Management Midwest (“Sims”) recycling facility. Sims, located at 2500 S. Paulina Street in the Pilsen community, is looking to renew their current permit. Community members are essential to this process and your attendance will help the City understand concerns and address them through permitting actions.

This meeting will follow the City’s public engagement [Guidelines](#) for waste and large recycling facilities, which also includes an ongoing public comment period. As a next step in this process, **CDPH will host a community meeting at Benito Juarez High School on October 19 at 6:00pm.**
