Re: Request for Waiver of Special Condition 9

Vulcan Construction Materials, LLC – Pershing Road Recycle

Dear Mr. Marante:

Vulcan Construction Materials, LLC (Vulcan) operates a reprocessable construction/demolition material facility located at 3910 S Racine Avenue in Chicago. The current City of Chicago Department of Public Health permit allows the facility to operate between the hours of 6:00 AM and 7:00 PM, Monday through Saturday. Vulcan has been requested by RailWorks Track Services, LLC to expand the hours of operation to accommodate the upcoming CTA Blue Line Traction Power Upgrades project. The project is scheduled to begin on or around March 4, 2023.

Under Special Condition #9 of the permit, Vulcan requests permission to extend the existing operating hours for this project. In addition to the standard operating hours, Vulcan would like to accept inbound material and ship outbound material between 3:00 AM and 6:00 AM each Saturday morning beginning on March 4, 2023 and ending on May 27, 2023.

In accordance with Special Condition 4 of the permit, Vulcan will not receive in excess of 436,800 tons per year or more than an average of 1,400 tons per day of reporcessable construction/demolition debris. As required by the permit, there will be no active processing of material during these extended hours and therefore, minimal noise or dust will be generated by the proposed additional activities. If fugitive dust is generated through unloading or shipping operations, the facility's water truck will be utilized to treat received material and control emissions. Vulcan is committed to be environmentally responsible for the properties we operate. Vulcan will adhere to the requirements of the facility's permit to continue to demonstrate compliance with the environmental sections of the City of Chicago Municipal Code.
