**Notice of 30-Day Extension of Comment Period for  
Five Variance Applications**

**For a Variance from the City of Chicago Rules and Regulations Pertaining to the Handling and Storage of Bulk Material Piles**

Pursuant to Section 8.0(5) of the City of Chicago Department of Public Health (CDPH) Rules and Regulations for Control of Emissions from the Handling and Storage of Bulk Material Piles, notice is hereby given this 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 2014 that, upon request from members of the public, CDPH is hereby extending the public comment period by thirty days from the latest current due date with respect to five variance applications submitted to CDPH on behalf of KCBX Terminals Company, Kinder Morgan/Chicago Area Terminal, North America Stevedoring, LLC, Horsehead Corporation, and S.H.
