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

CDPH Office of the CMO: Inception

- Launched summer of 2022
- Born out of organizational planning taking lessons learned from the COVID-19 response
- Identified need to define and refine CDPH's role in the broader Chicago health ecosystem



CDPH Office of the CMO: Mission

The CDPH Office of the CMO's mission is to collaborate, convene, and strengthen ties with Chicago healthcare providers in service of **promoting health equity** in the Chicago healthcare ecosystem and to **optimize access to care** for all Chicagoans.



The Office aims to **bridge the gap between public health and the healthcare system** to ensure healthcare service delivery citywide aligns with public health goals and strategies, including but not limited to those outlined in Healthy Chicago 2025.

Healthcare System Coordination: Internal Goals

- Engage cross-departmentally with all bureaus at CDPH in order to de-silo and coordinate CDPH's partnerships with the Chicago healthcare system
 - Primary centralized team for healthcare system-related information, communication, engagement, and strategic planning
 - Document and track all existing partnerships with the healthcare system
 - Connect dots between people, programs, and projects





Healthcare System Coordination: External Goals

- Create sustainable relationships with healthcare providers across the Chicago healthcare system
 - Promote and cultivate shared public health priorities
 - Efficient, coordinated, and equitable public health emergency responses
 - Racial equity—Healthy Chicago 2025
 - Promote public health best practices
 - Collaborate to identify and problem-solve barriers to accessing health care
 - Foster bi-directional institutional transparency, accountability, and accessibility





Healthcare System Coordination: 2023 Top Priorities

- *Readiness, Recovery, Resilience*
- Cultivate and sustain relationships with Chicago safety net and community health providers
- Improve coordination with healthcare providers during CDPH public health emergency responses
- Improve communications with healthcare providers via the Chicago Health Alert Network
