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




### Organizational Chart-Bureau of Public Health and Emergency Response




# Background


Assure healthcare system coordination during public health emergencies through shared preparedness planning, training, exercise, and response with Chicago's 35 hospitals, 400+ healthcare partners, the Chicago Healthcare Coalition and regional and statewide partners Monitor regional medical surge capabilities for both real and scheduled public health and citywide events

Build and maintain local cache of emergency medical supplies and coordinate receipt of assets from the federal Strategic National Stockpile (SNS) (i.e. ventilators, PPE, burn and medical supplies) Collaborate with local, regional, and state authorities before and during emergencies to coordinate patient movement, patient tracking, and to share critical information with healthcare partners Manage the Chicago Medical Reserve Corps (*Chicago MRC*)
