Pre-1850's: Early Sanitation

- Board of Health established
- First sanitation regulations passed
- Focus on disease control





1850-1920: Sanitary Reform

- Focus on sewers, water, food & dairy
- Reporting of contagious diseases required
- Reversal of river as medical intervention



1880's-1950's: Hygiene Movement

- Focus on hygiene and medical care
- First infant mortality campaign
- Services for dental, home visits and venereal diseases



1920's: The New Public Health

- Inoculations as major intervention
- Syphilis Control Project 1937
- City introduces Salk vaccine 1955



1950's: Health Care Services

- Personal health care services
- Focus on low-income populations
- First City Mental Health Center 1959
- First Neighborhood Health center 1970
