

	Travel Advisory	Required upon arrival in Chicago
Red	Avoid travel	14-day quarantine
Orange	Avoid travel	14-day quarantine or Pre-arrival negative test result with strict masking, social distancing and avoidance of in-person gatherings.
Yellow	Avoid non- essential travel	No quarantine or pre-arrival test required. Maintain strict masking and social distancing.




Severe Warning: Chicago cases are still growing without signs of slowing. Doubling time at 12 days.




Severe Warning: Test positivity more than 3 times early October, despite breaking testing records daily.



Severe Warning: Chicago COVID-19 cases have continued to dramatically increase across ALL race-ethnicity groups.




Severe Warning: Chicago COVID-19 cases have continued to dramatically increase across ALL age groups.



Warning: More than 3 times as many people hospitalized (non-ICU) in Chicago with COVID-19 as in early October.




Non-ICU beds occupied by COVID-19 patients

Includes confirmed and suspected COVID-19 cases.


Warning: More than 3 times as many people in Chicago ICUs with COVID-19 as in early October.

- Both companies plan for FDA submission in coming weeks


COVID-19 Vaccine

Vaccine Prioritization

- Plans based on the national guidance
- Healthcare workers (HCW) first population recommended to receive vaccine
 - HCW who care for COVID-19 patients and perform certain procedures will be prioritized first
