



As of 12/1, Chicago's travel order includes 46 states, as well as two territories






	Travel Advisory	Required upon arrival in Chicago
Red	Avoid travel	14-day quarantine
Orange	Avoid travel	14-day quarantine <u>Or</u> Pre-arrival negative test result with strict masking, social distancing and avoidance of in-person gatherings.
Yellow	Avoid non- essential travel	No quarantine or pre-arrival test required. Maintain strict masking and social distancing.


New COVID-19 cases in Chicago have peaked, though still very high, and 5X greater than late September. Monitoring for potential post-Thanksgiving surge.

Chicago Hospital Non-ICU Bed Occupancy from COVID-19






Acute non-ICU bed counts include burn, emergency department, med/surg, other, pediatrics and psychiatry beds in Chicago hospitals. Includes Chicago and non-Chicago residents. Includes confirmed and suspected COVID-19 cases.

COVID-19 deaths have risen 5X in 5 weeks (since 10/19). Deaths have *not* peaked yet.


