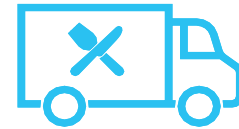

- More details forthcoming



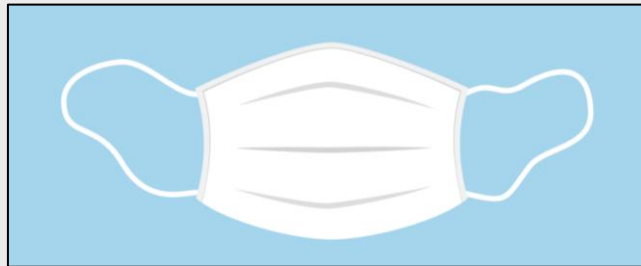

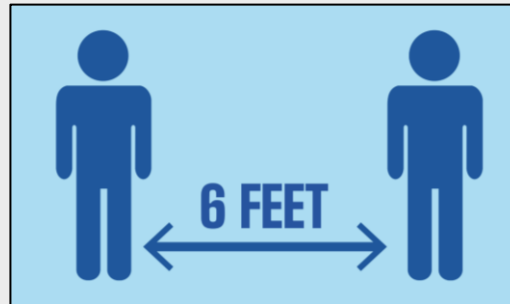
Wear a face covering

- At home if a household member has COVID symptoms



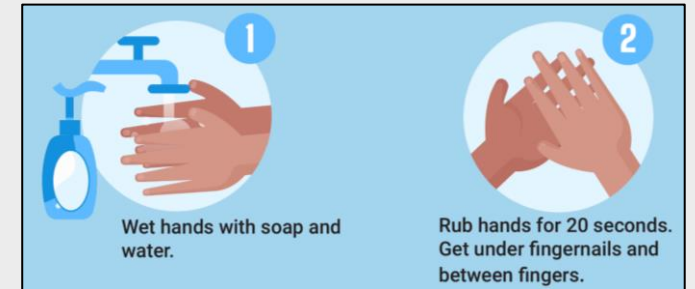
Maintain social distance & avoid gatherings

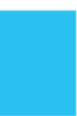

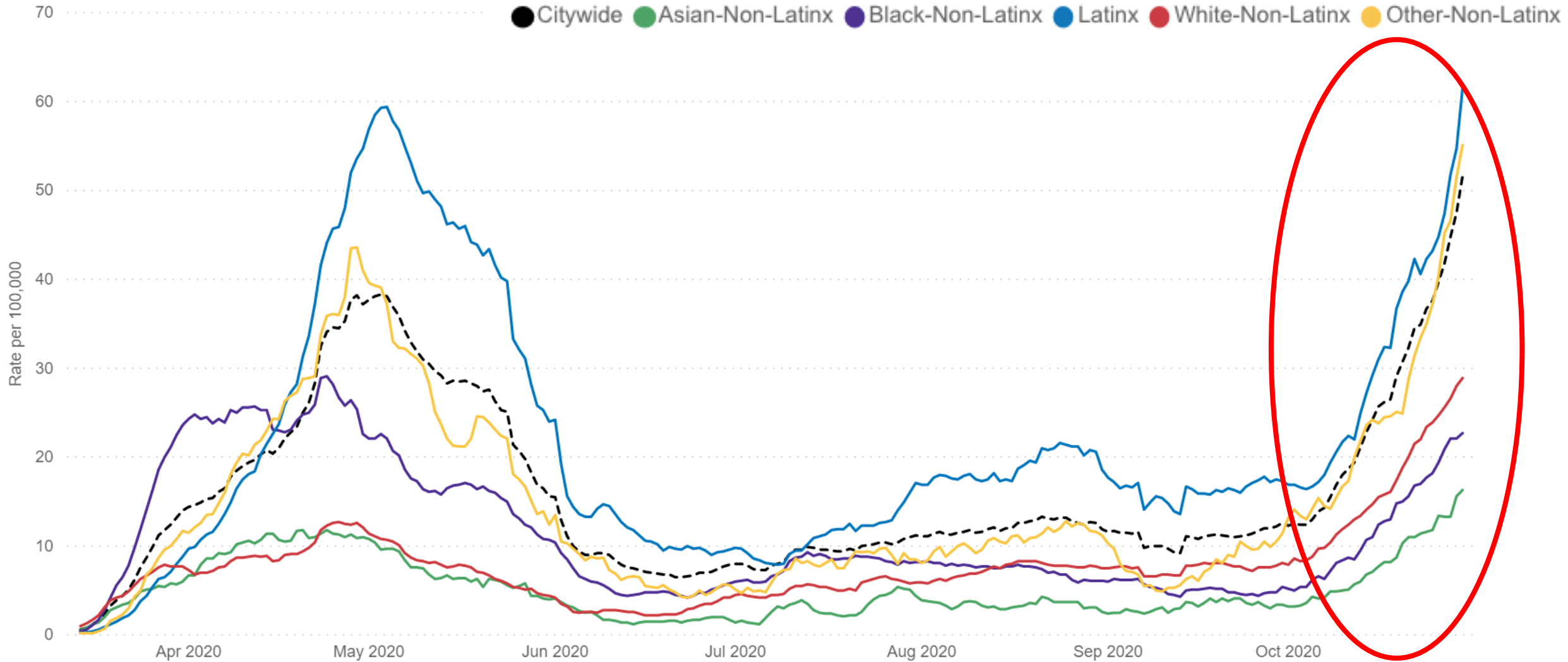

Severe Warning: Chicago cases are still growing without signs of slowing; doubling time at 12 days

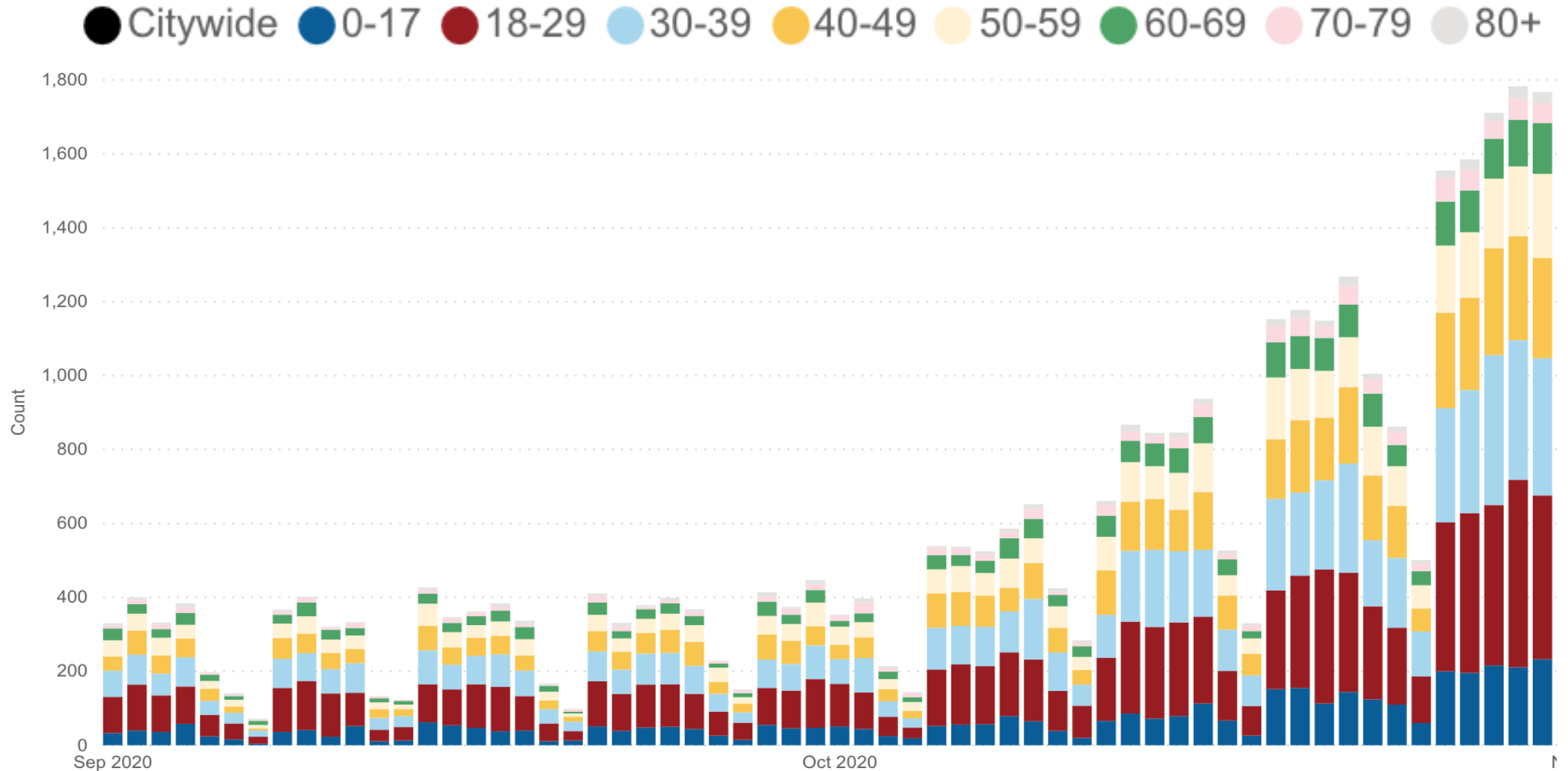


Severe Warning: Chicago COVID-19 cases have continued to dramatically increase across ALL race-ethnicity groups

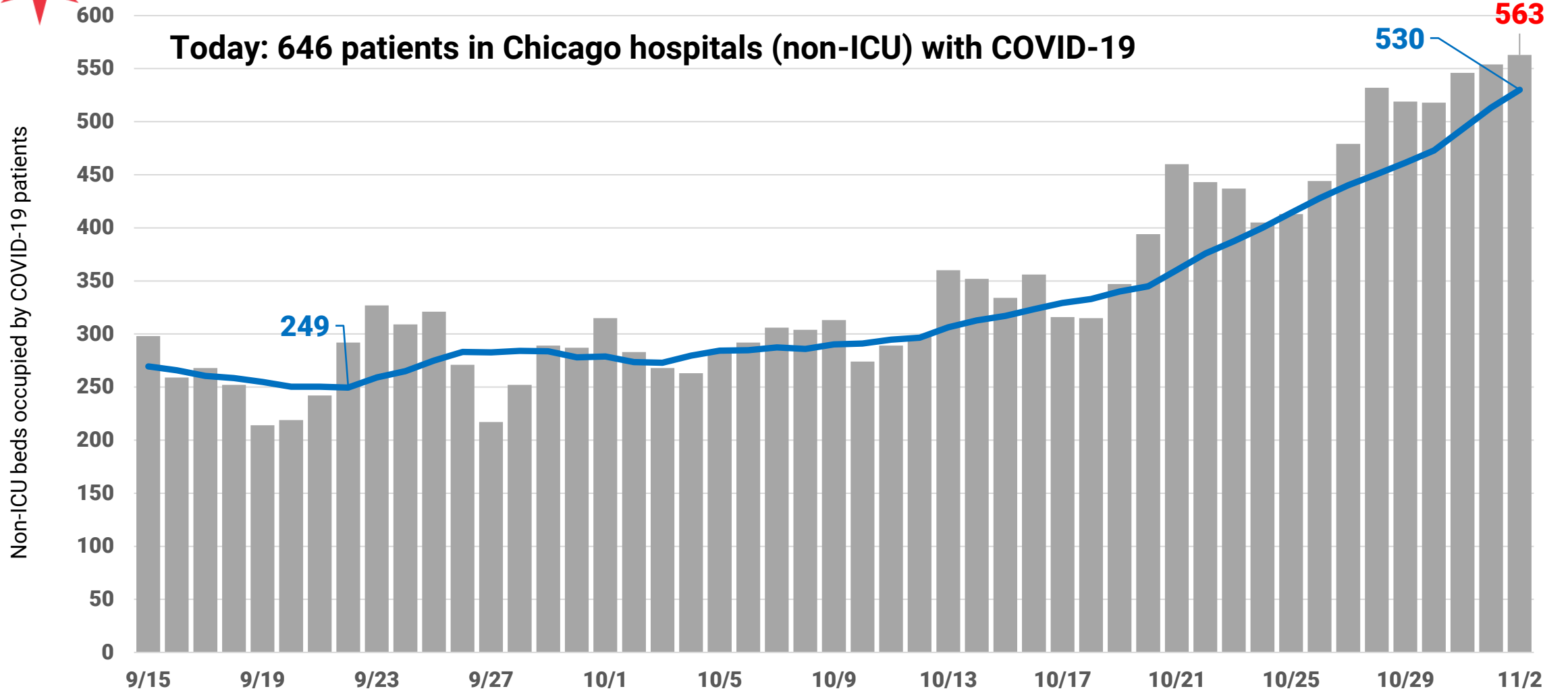


Severe Warning: Chicago cases have continued to dramatically increase across all age groups, *including among older Chicagoans*

Cases in age 40-49 and 30-39 year-olds now matching 18-29 y/o

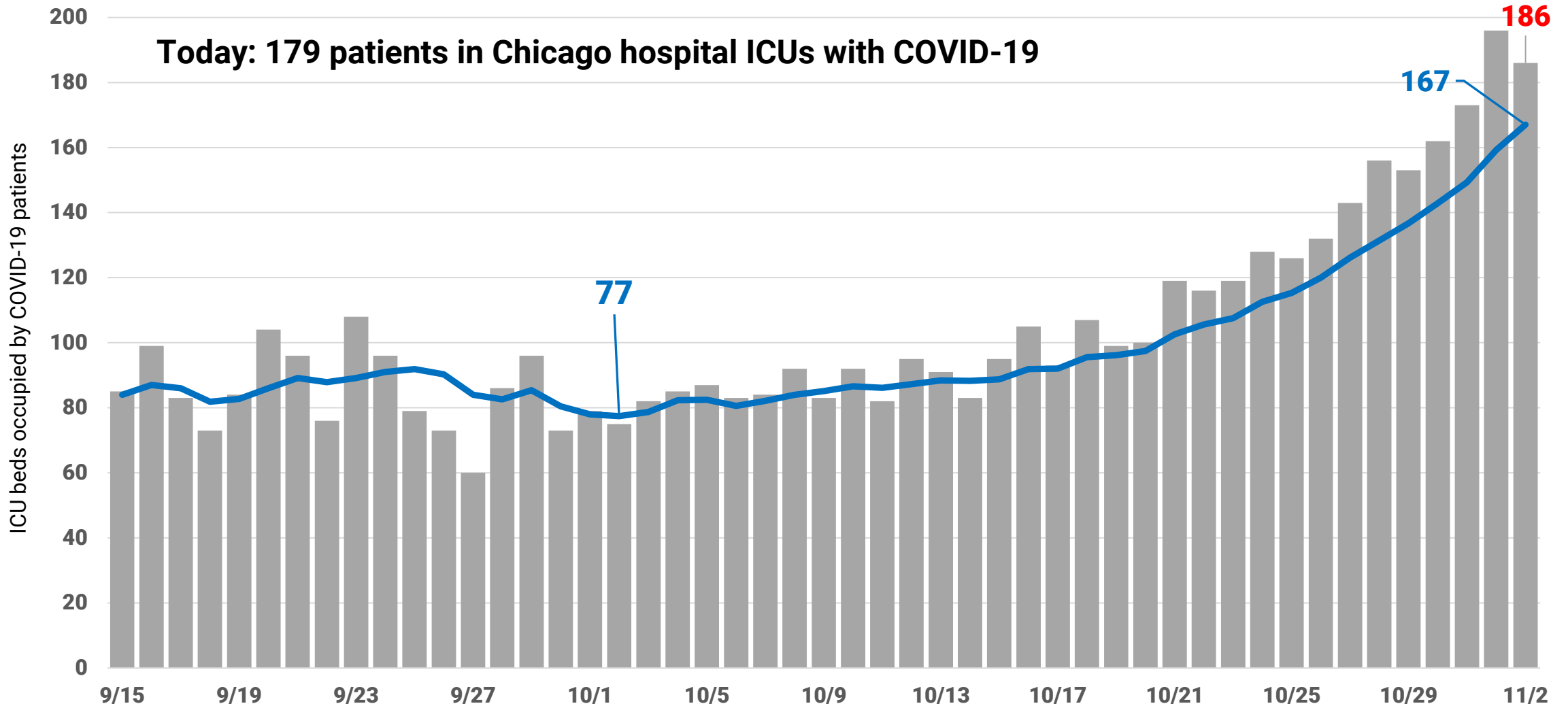


Warning: More than **twice** as many people hospitalized (non-ICU) with COVID-19 in Chicago hospitals as in late September

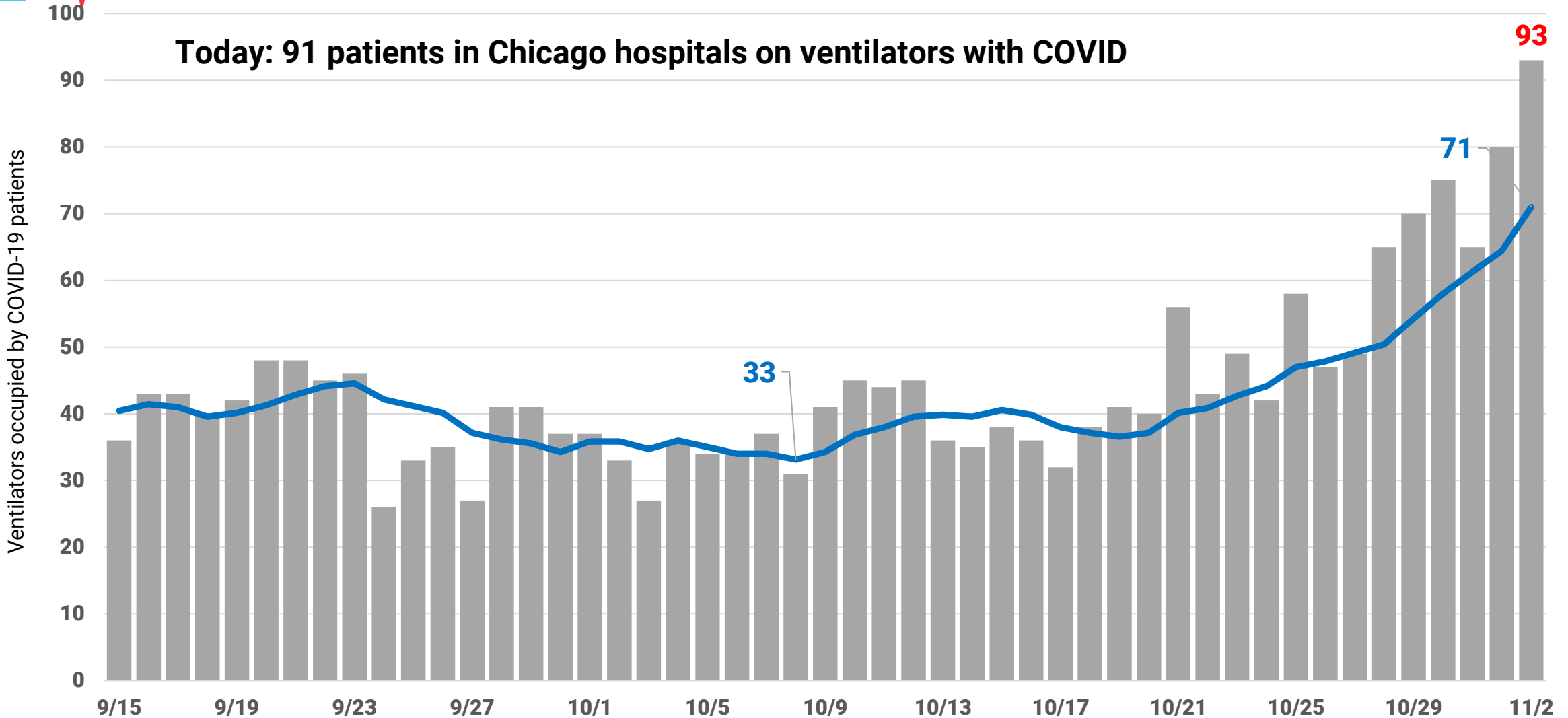


COVID patients and COVID patients under investigation, as reported by Chicago hospitals
