



COVID-19 Testing and Percent Positivity






Calculating Current Percent Positivity (Citywide)




X Daily Hospitalizations and Deaths Continue to Decrease

Daily COVID-19 hospitalizations and 7-day rolling average




Chicago resident COVID-19 cases who have been hospitalized, by date of first hospitalization Results for several previous days are updated each day.

Daily COVID-19 deaths and 7-day rolling average






Later Daily Case Rates By Age Group, March to July






Daily Case Rates By Age Group Over Last Month






Since June 15, Most New Chicago Cases Have Been in Young Adults (Aged 18–29)

Percent of New Infections By Age Group






Race and Ethnicity for New Chicago Cases Aged 18–29






COVID-19 Testing and Percent Positivity among Chicagoans Aged 18-29 Years Stable Since Mid-June




