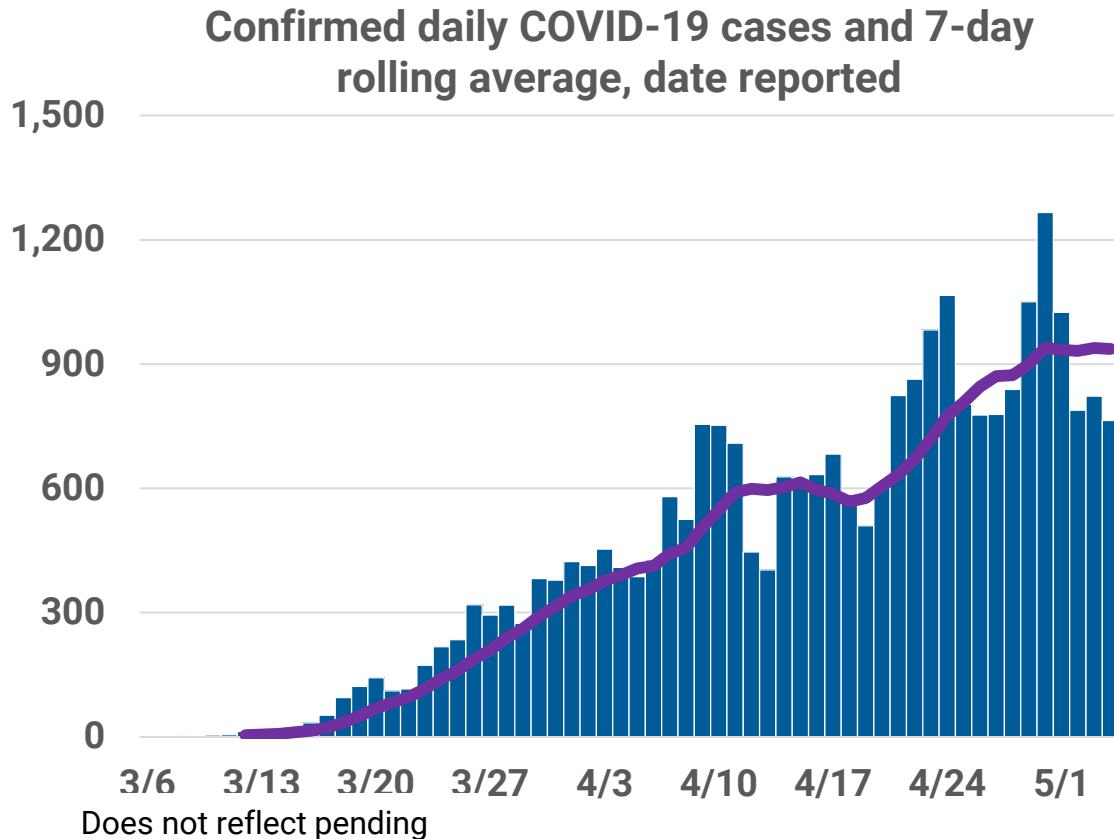

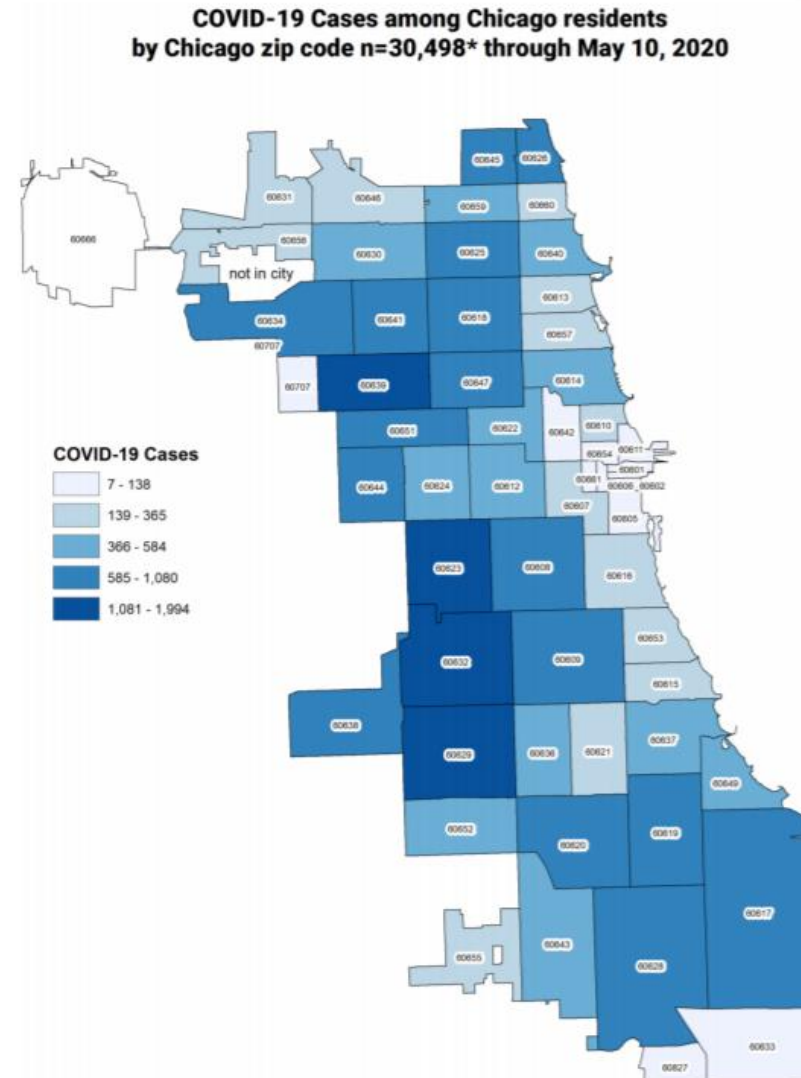

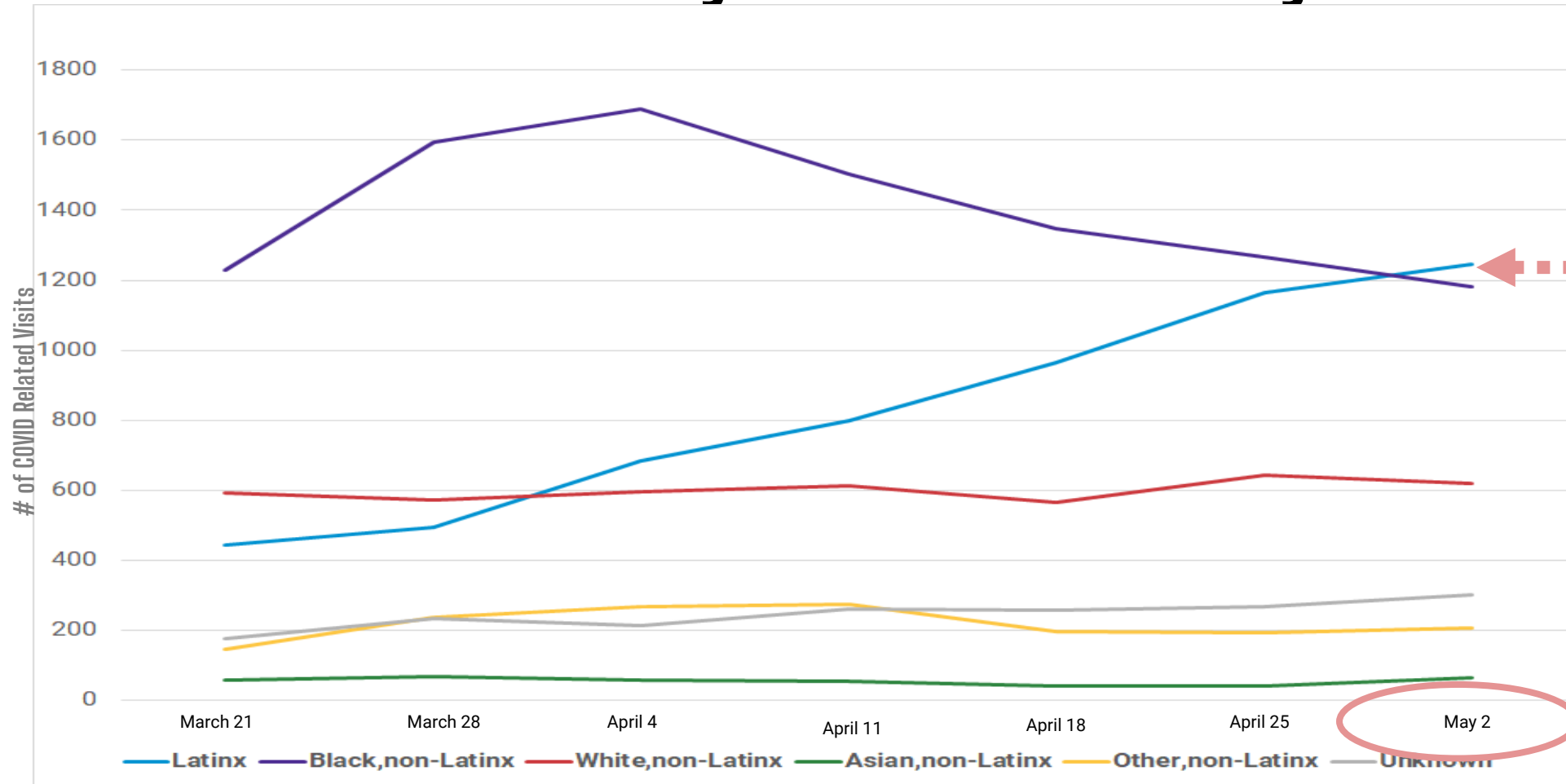

 - Gage Park

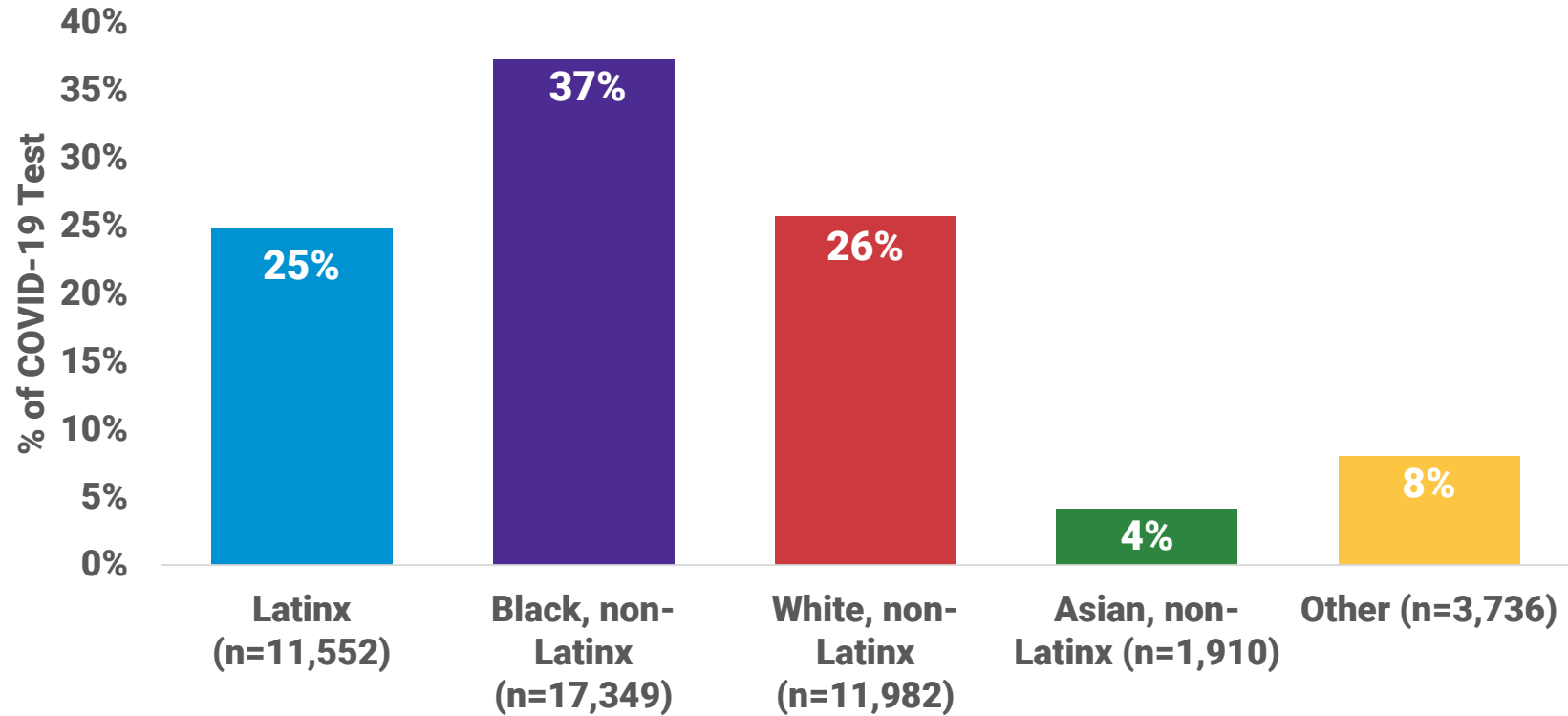


★ COVID related ED visits by Race and Ethnicity

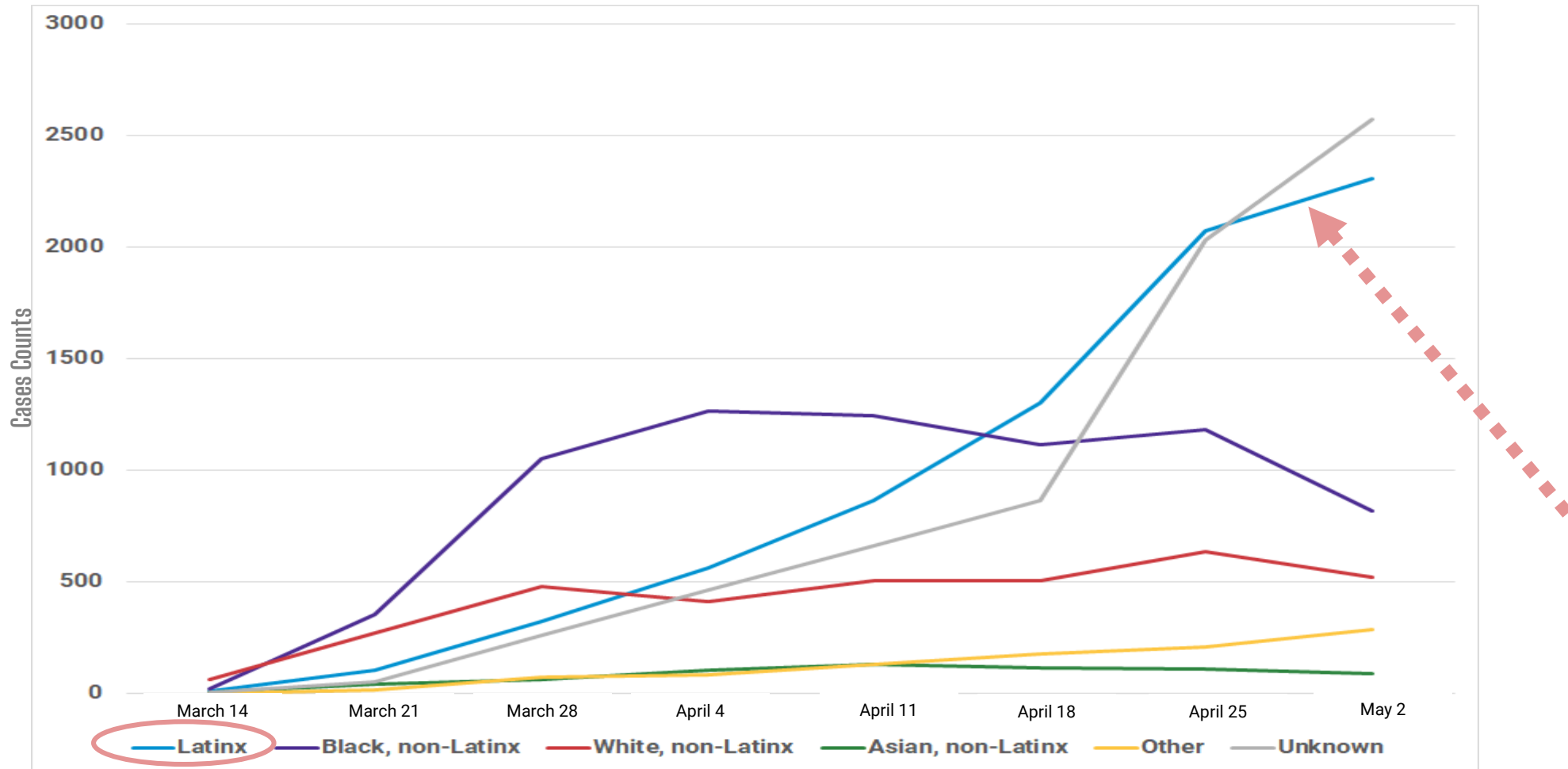
★ COVID-19 Testing by Race-Ethnicity*

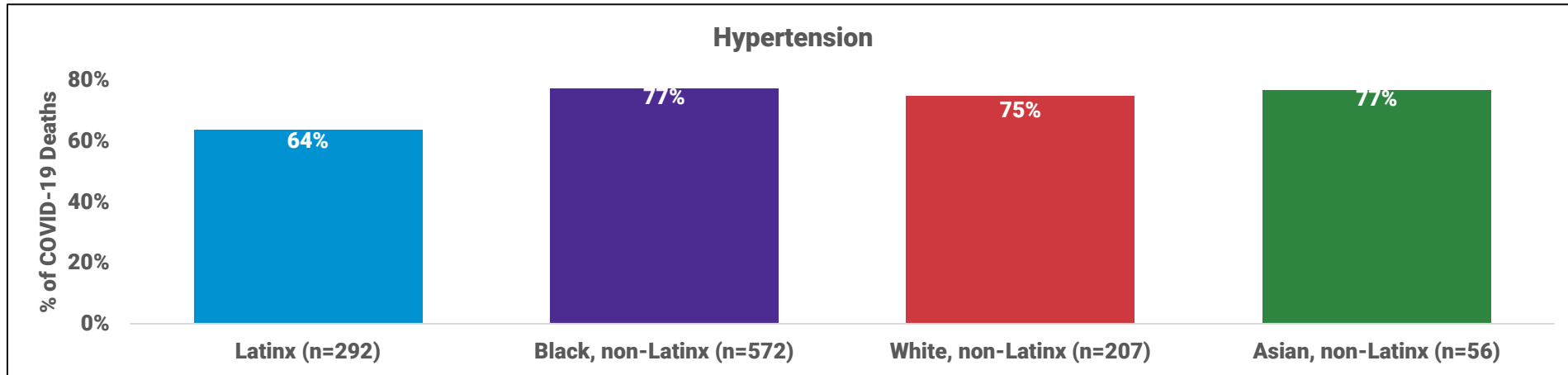
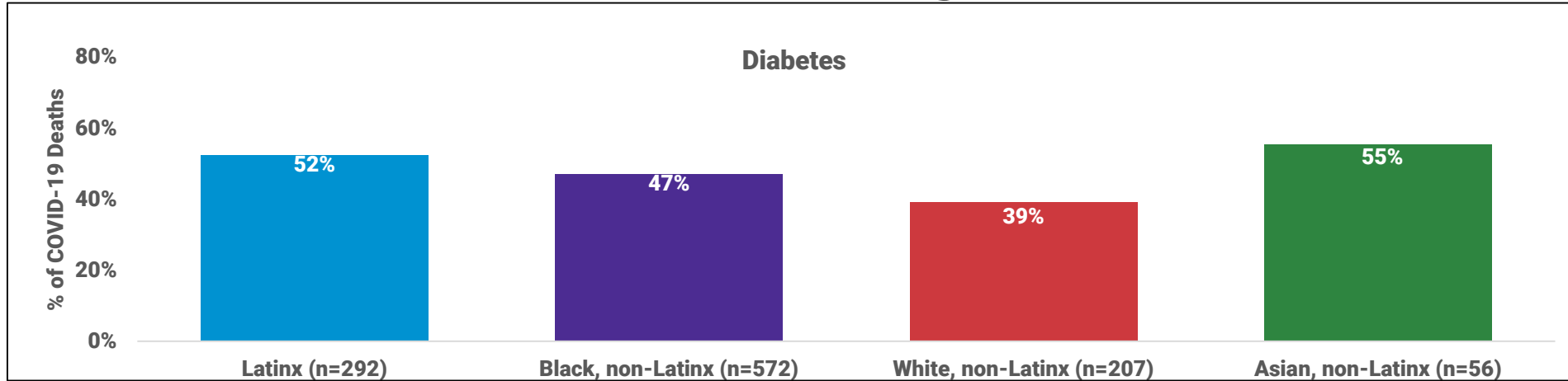
★ Cases by Race and Ethnicity Over Time

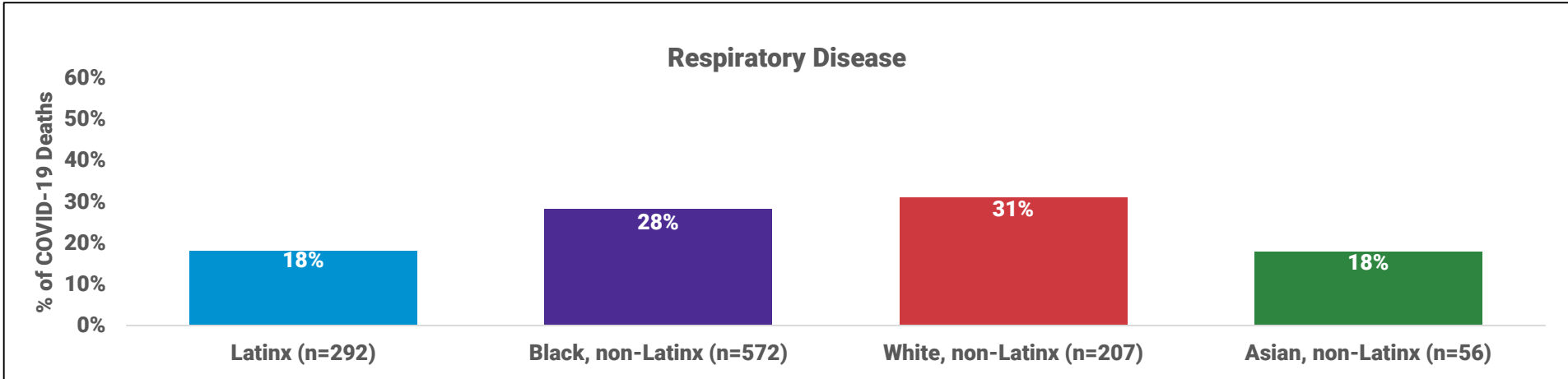
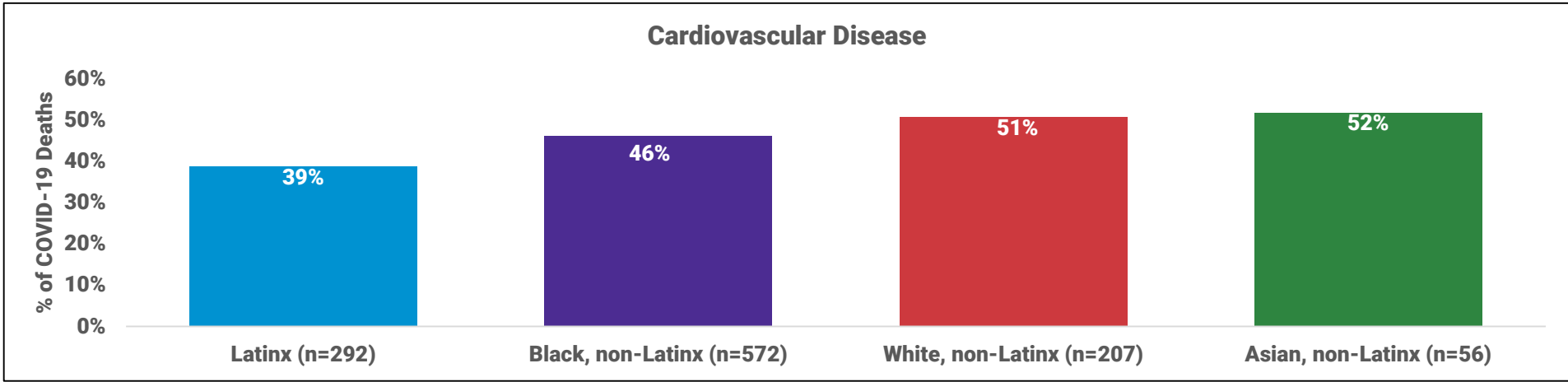

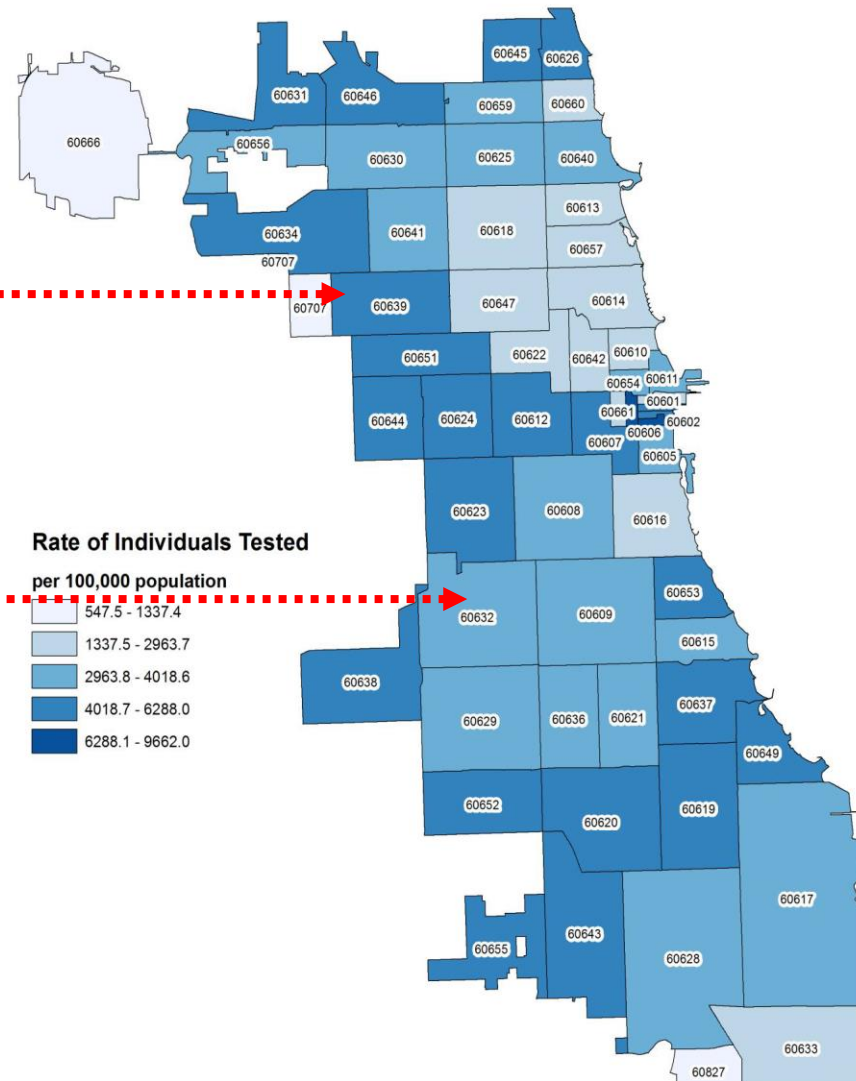
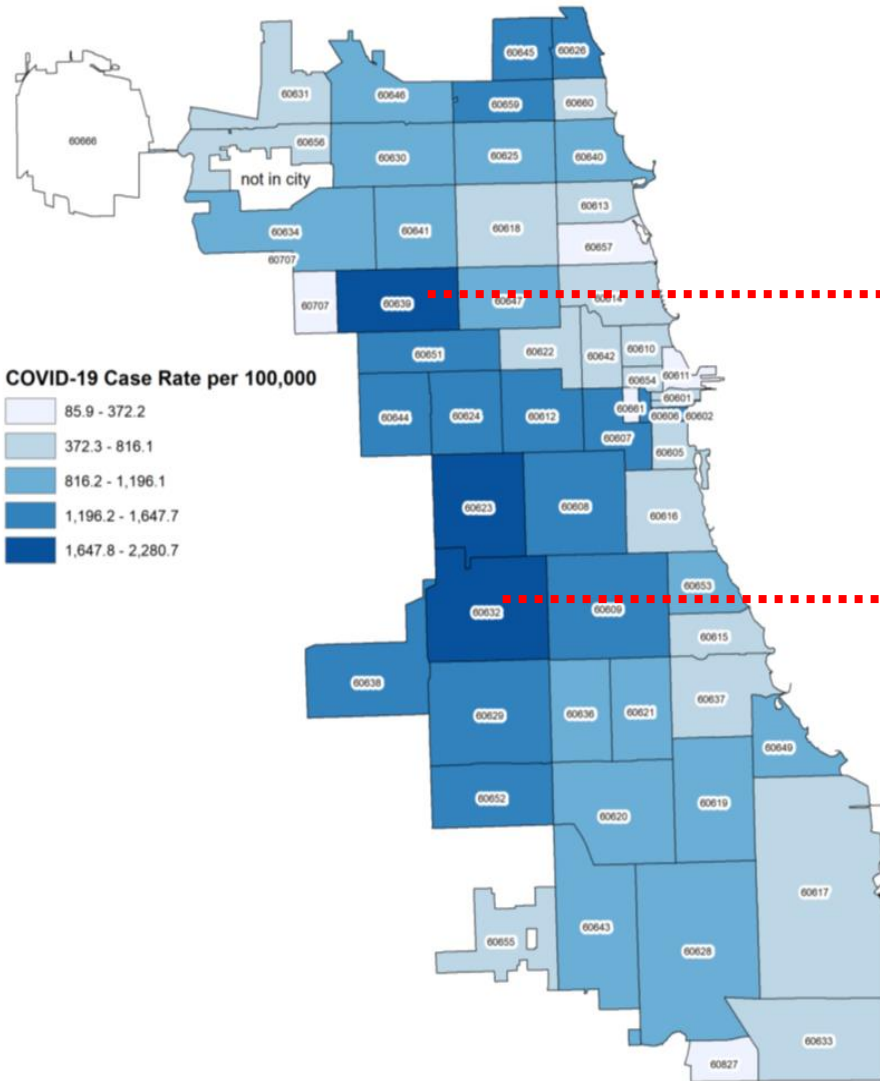
Risk Factors for COVID Mortality

*93% of people who die have underlying conditions



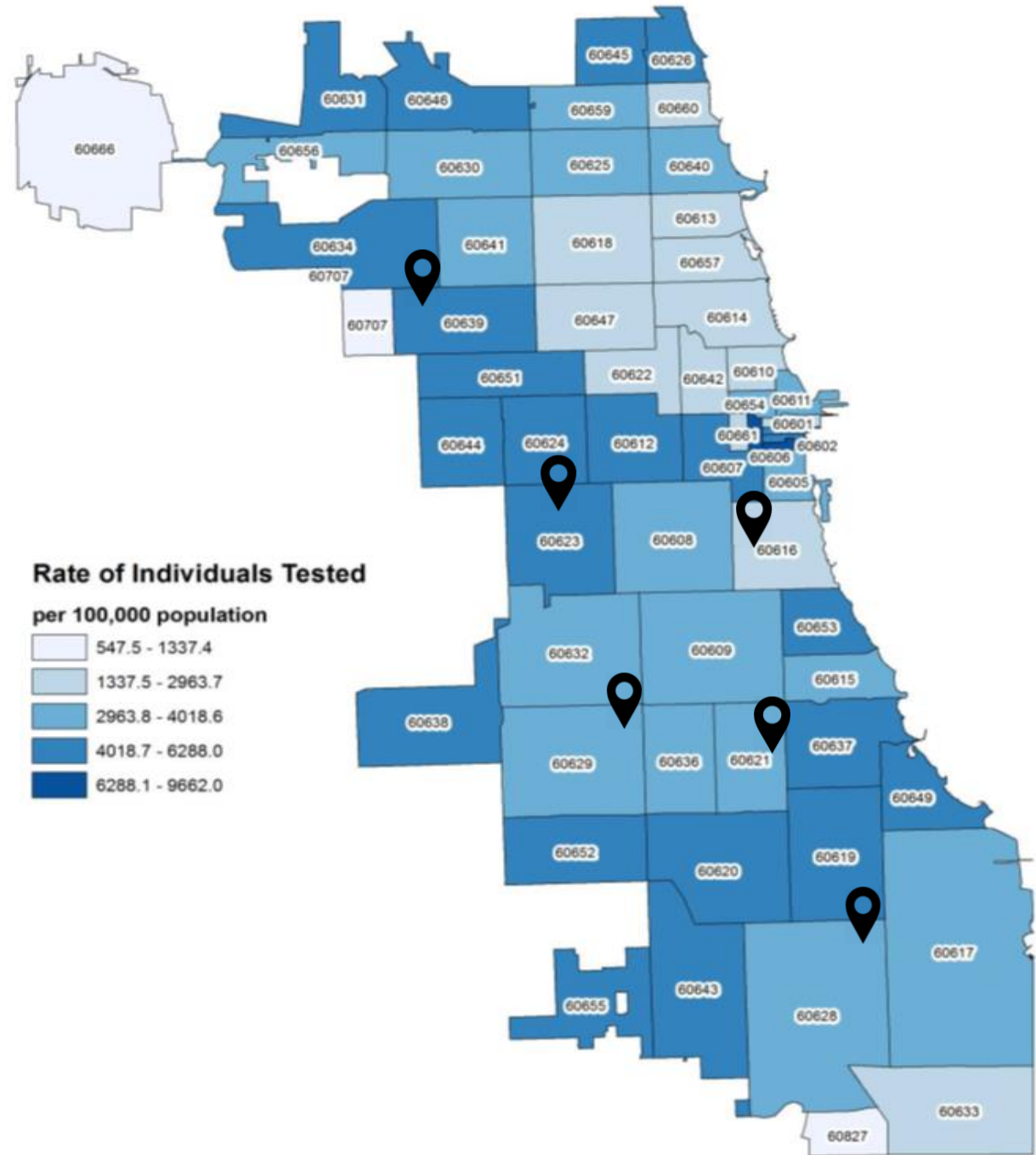
