


# As of 09/21, Chicago's travel order consists of 18 states and Puerto Rico. Wisconsin, Montana, Idaho, Minnesota, & Puerto Rico added. Kentucky & Louisiana removed.



### **Wisconsin Situation**




- 31 average daily cases/100K
- Worst in country after Dakotas, still increasing
- Widespread: would quarantine individually for 71% (51 of the 72) counties in state

#### Confirmed daily COVID-19 cases and 7-day rolling average




**Current** new cases/day

#### COVID-19 testing and percent positivity, 7-day rolling average




**Current Test Positivity** 4.6%




#### \* Hospitalizations and Deaths, Chicago

Chicago resident COVID-19 cases who have been hospitalized, by date of first hospitalization. Results for several previous days are updated each day.


#### Daily COVID-19 deaths and 7-day rolling average
