

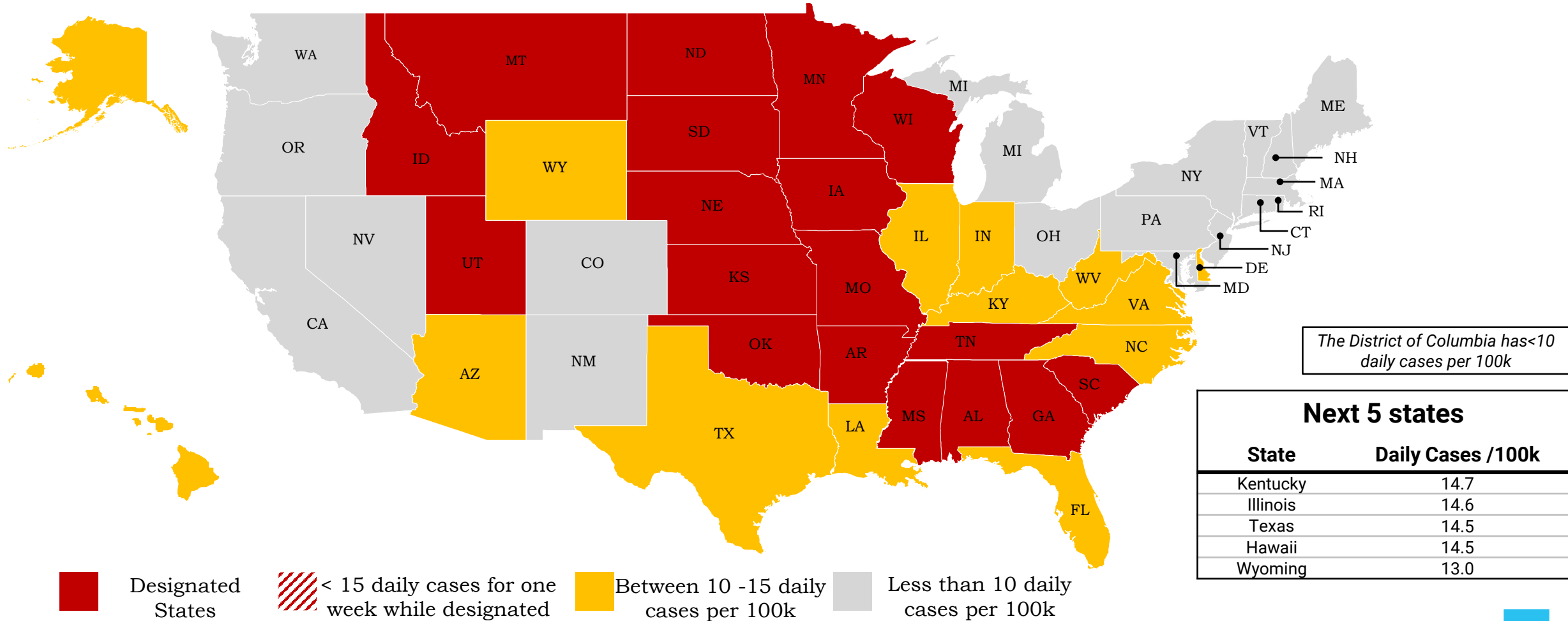


COVID-19 Update

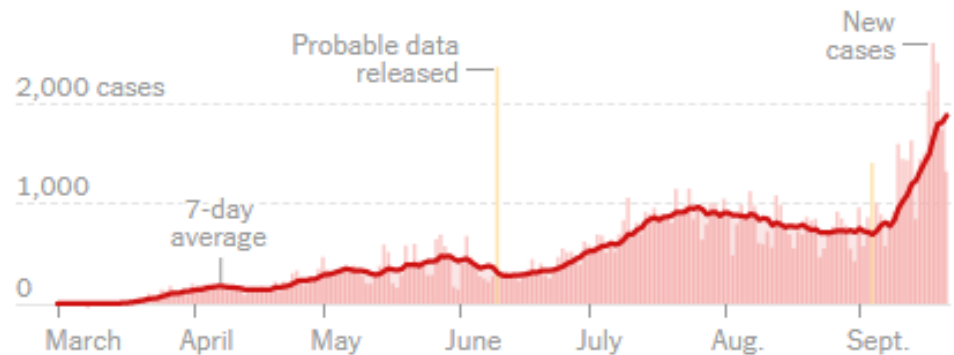


As of 09/21, Chicago's travel order consists of 18 states and Puerto Rico. Wisconsin, Montana, Idaho, Minnesota, & Puerto Rico added. Kentucky & Louisiana removed.



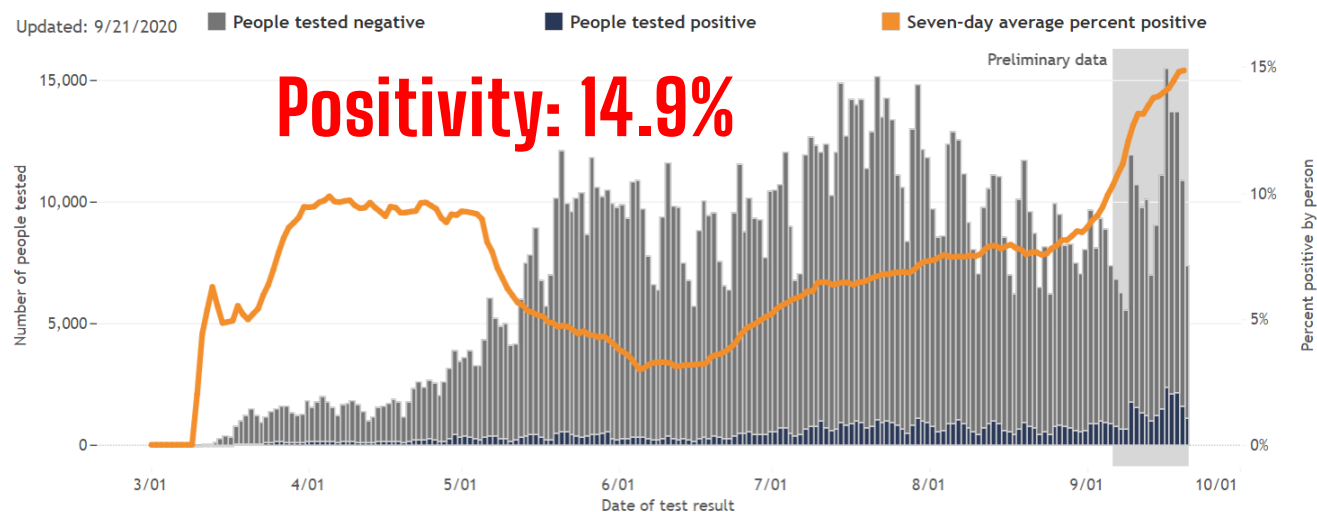
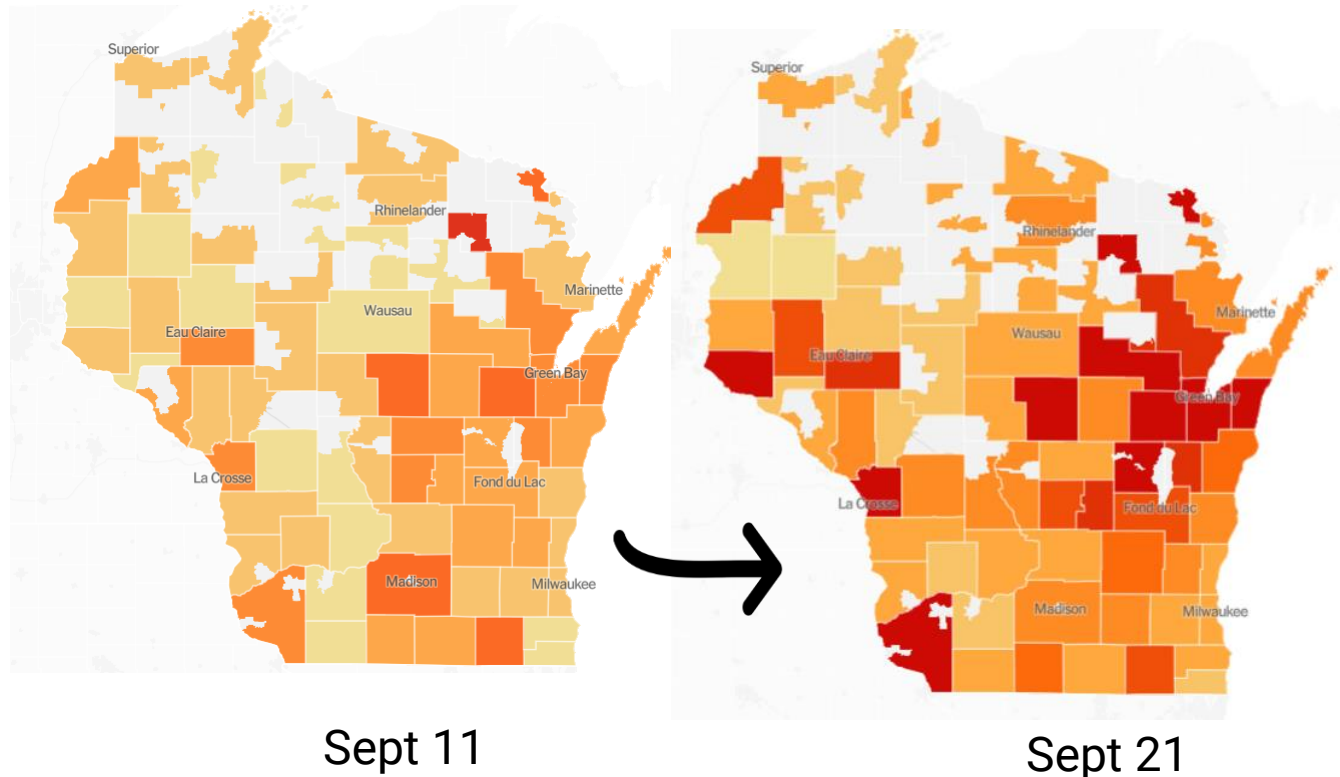
Note: *This State was on the designated list and is now under 15 daily cases per 100k residents, if they stay below for another week, it will be taken off the list

Wisconsin Situation

Deaths	1,253	3	-24%

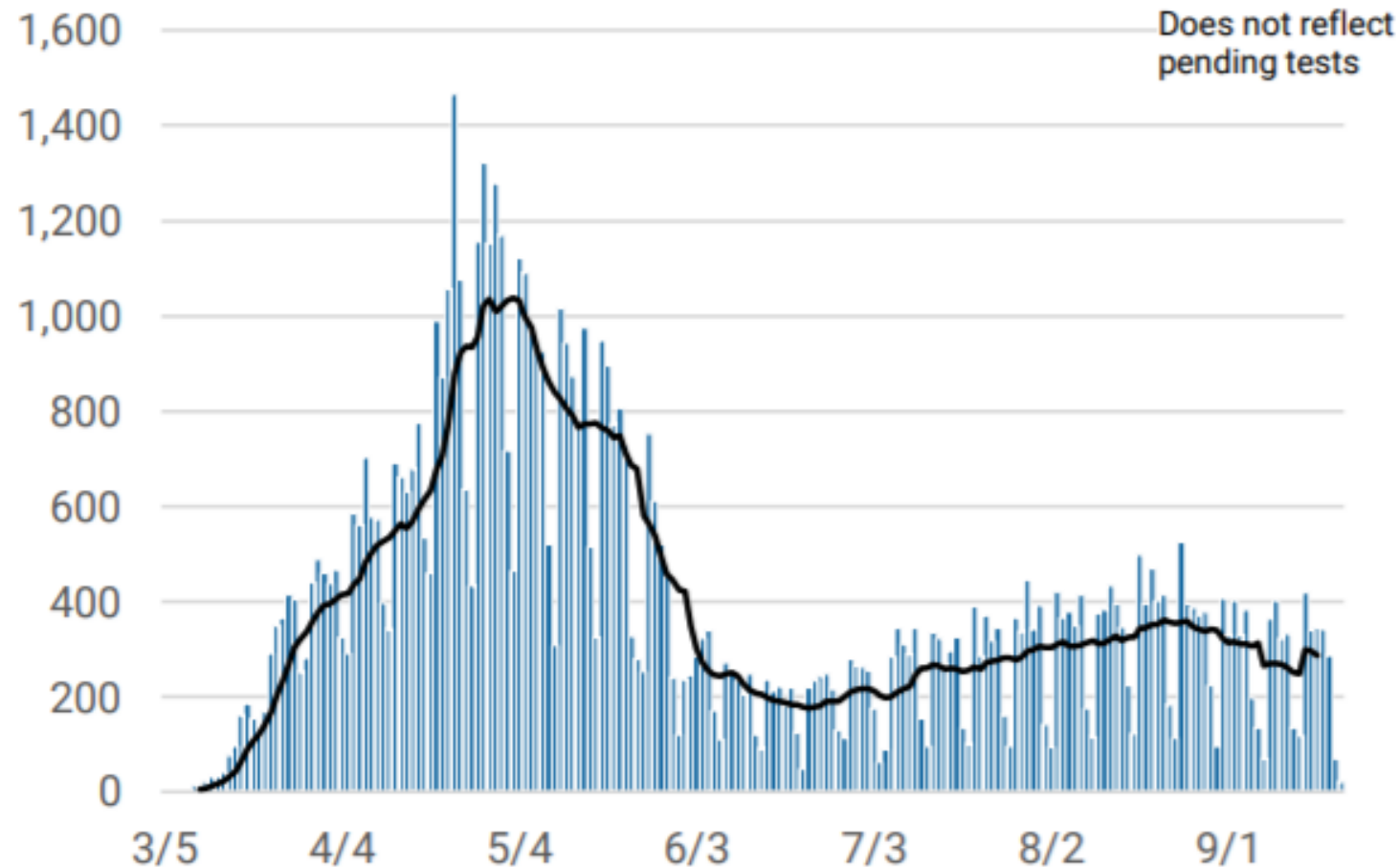
- 31 average daily cases/100K
- Worst in country after Dakotas, still increasing
- Widespread: would quarantine individually for 71% (51 of the 72) counties in state

★ New Daily COVID-19 Cases, Chicago

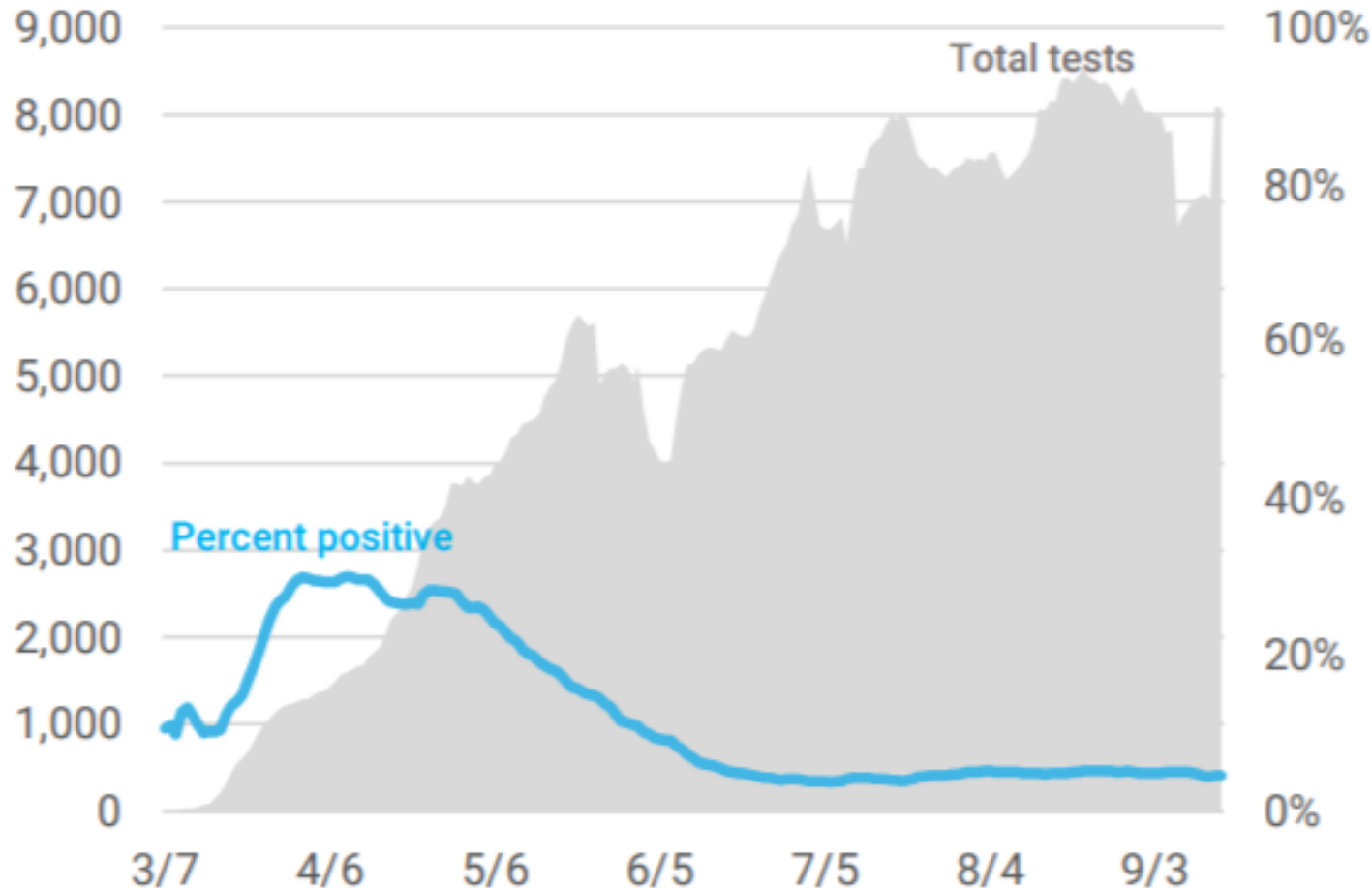
Confirmed daily COVID-19 cases and 7-day rolling average

COVID-19 testing and percent positivity, 7-day rolling average

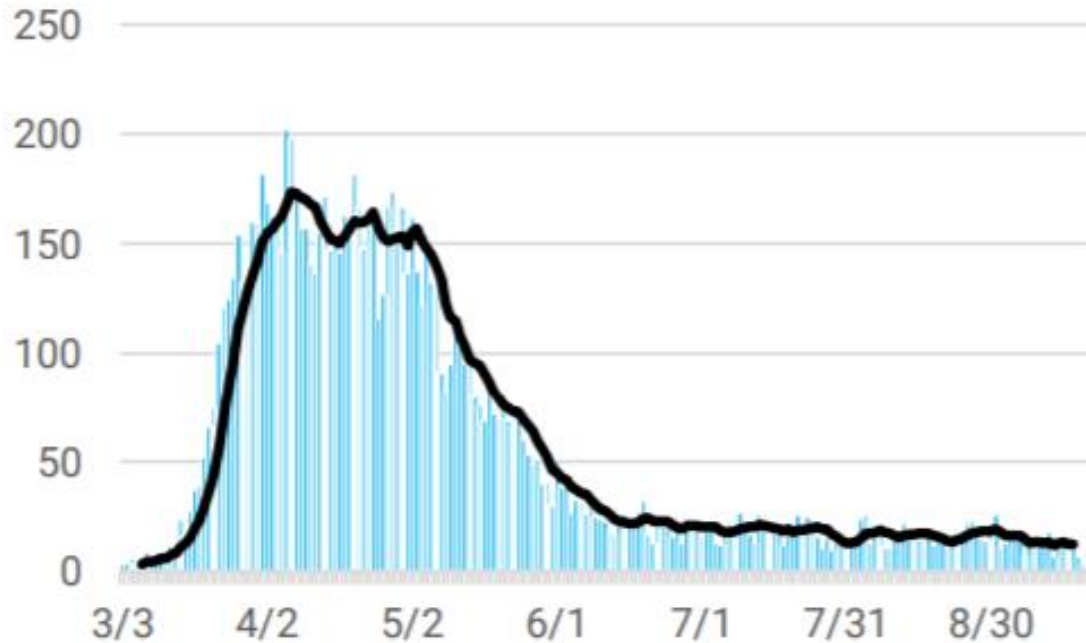

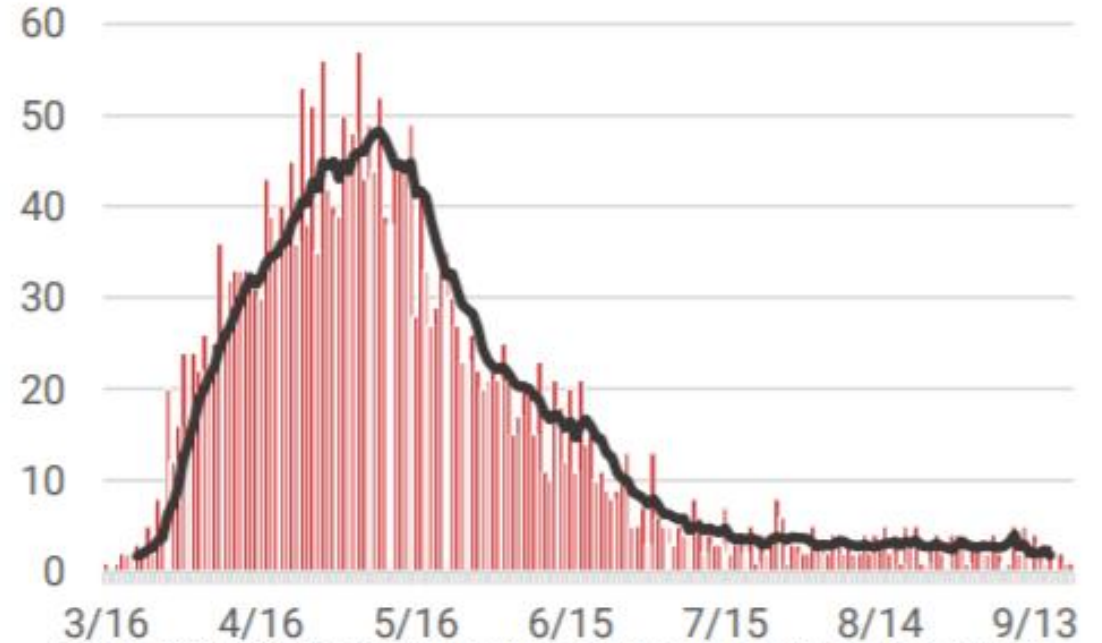
★ Hospitalizations and Deaths, Chicago

Daily COVID-19 deaths and 7-day rolling average

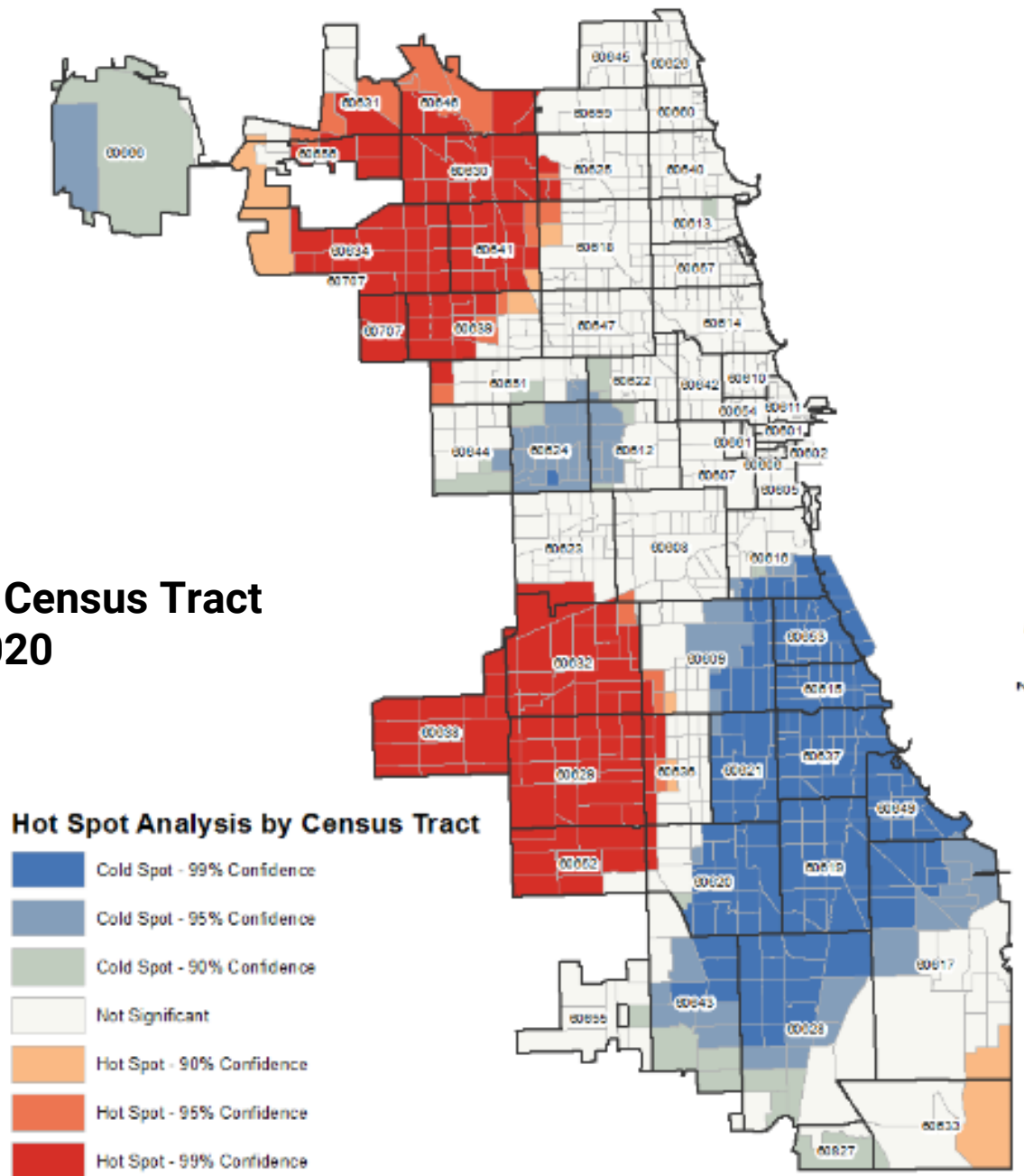


Chicago resident COVID-19 cases who have died, by date of death. Results for several previous days are updated each day.

★ Chicago Influenza (Flu) Planning

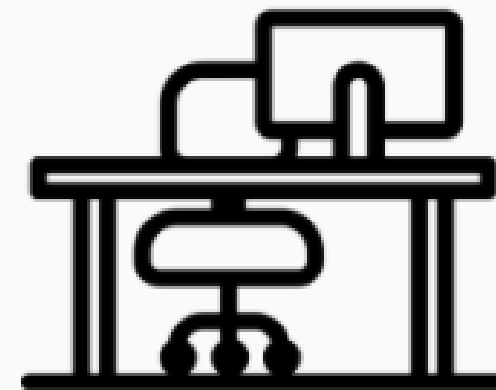
CDPH plans to distribute nearly 325,000 no-cost flu shots, most through clinical offices. Many more will be given through partners:
