ORDER

On March 24, 2014, the Superintendent of Police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago charges against Police Officer William J. Donovan, Star No. 13485 (hereinafter referred to as “Respondent”), recommending that the Respondent be suspended from the Chicago Police Department for a period of sixty (60) days for violating several Rules of Conduct.

On June 17, 2014, the Superintendent moved to withdraw the charges against the Respondent without prejudice, stating that the parties have entered into a settlement agreement regarding this matter. The Police Board has considered the Superintendent’s motion.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Superintendent’s motion is **granted**.
